The arts have always had periods of rise and decline, and the marked decline which occurred early in the last century is said to have been caused in part by the application of steam power to machinery; the great ease of production causing the excessive use of ornamentation. A movement set in characterized by a return to simplicity of design, appropriate ornament and the substitution of hand work for machine work wherever it was possible. A small band of workers, headed by William Morris, led the revival which spread from England to the continent and finally to our own country. This widespread interest in applied art has caused an activity which has sometimes resulted in extravagance, but which on the whole has been productive of great improvement in all manufactured articles.

In forming a Society of Applied Art in Canada, the aim has been the encouragement of original design and its individual expression. This object it hopes to promote by holding exhibitions of original Canadian work, the names of the designer and executant being always given; by occasional loan exhibits; by lectures; and by rendering the literature on the subject of handicraft accessible to those who are interested.

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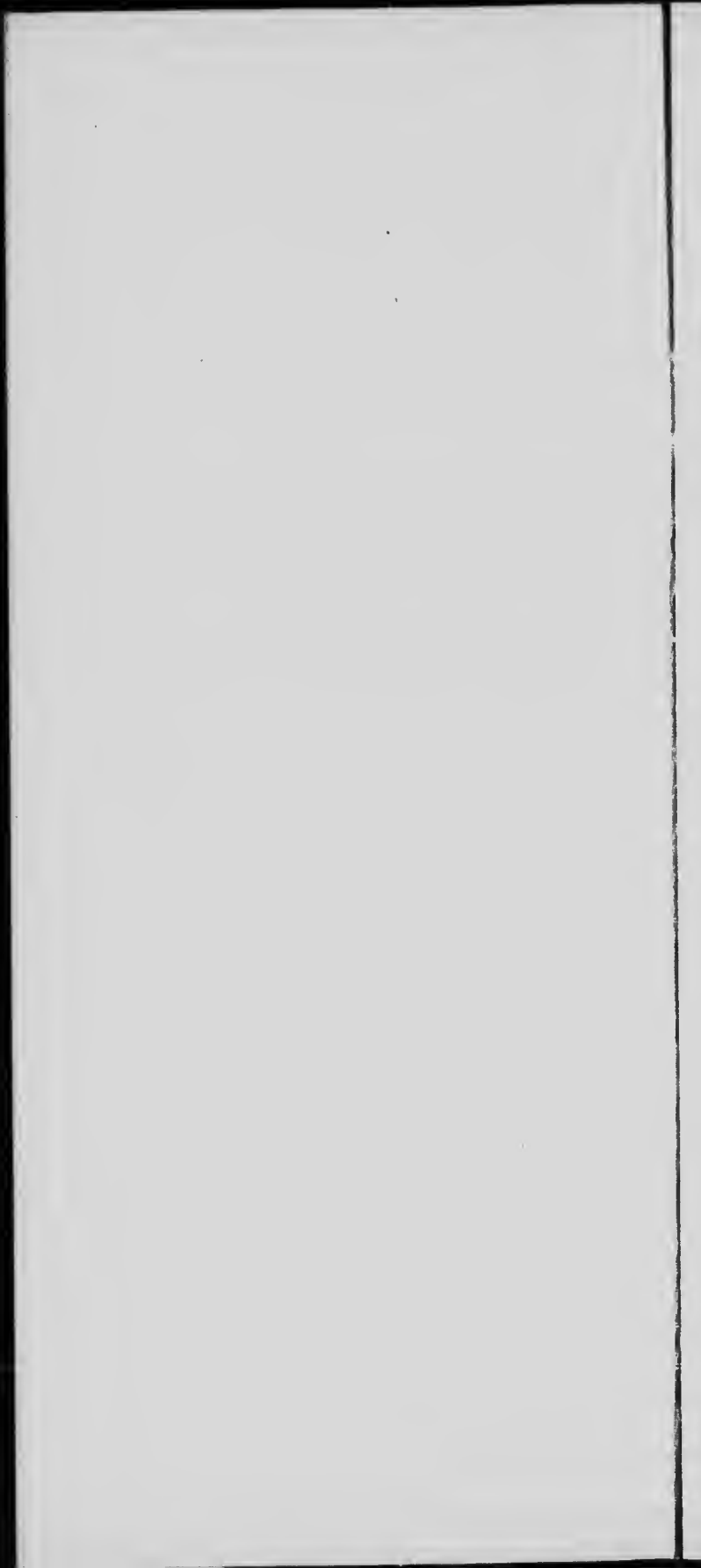
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The Society has a working and an associate membership, the annual fee for both classes of members being \$1.00.
