

IT WAS A HURRICANE.

Terrific Wind Storm in Minnesota and Dakota Friday—Other Big Storms. St. Paul, July 7.—A great storm raged over Western and Central Minnesota and Dakota yesterday. The wind reached the velocity of a hurricane. At Shakopee, Minn., the great building of the Wagoner Furniture Company was so badly wrecked that it was impossible to run the machinery. The loss is \$5000. The cooper building was demolished and Kelly's hardware store wrecked. Several frame residences and barns were blown away, and trees and fences torn up and thrown across the highways in a way as to prevent travel. At Redwood Falls, Minn., several buildings were toppled over and some burned by lightning. Much damage to fences and crops is reported from the country. At St. Paul, Minn., lightning struck a three-story building, one a barn containing several valuable horses. Many hundreds of acres of corn were destroyed by hail. Many buildings were blown down in the vicinity of Rowell, Minn., where the storm swept a strip of country twenty miles wide. At Villa had considerable damage to growing wheat, corn and oats.

Have an Edwardburg, Mich.

CHICAGO, July 7.—A destructive wind-storm struck the town of Edwardburg, Mich., about 1 o'clock last night, blowing in from the west. The town consists of about 100 inhabitants, and contains between 200 and 300 buildings. It is situated on the Grand Trunk Railway, 135 miles from Chicago, on the shores of Lake St. Clair. The storm struck the village with terrific force, overturning and carrying away many of the houses. There is not a house in the place but what is damaged to more or less extent, and the town is almost a complete wreck.

Arkansas Counties Suffer.

St. Louis, July 7.—Advice to the Post-Dispatch from from Evading Shado, Ark., that a terrible rain and hail storm had struck the county of Boone, Ark., on Wednesday. The damage was great. Sixty-five farmers in the vicinity of Chanolia lost everything in the way of crops, corn, oats and cotton being entirely destroyed. A 14-year-old boy was sent to his grave during the storm.
