An Act to amend the Act to amend the several Acts to remedy abuses prejudicial to Agriculture.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act which amends the several Acts to remedy abuses prejudicial to Agriculture, in so far as it relates to lands forming the beaches of the River St. Lawrence in the County of Charlevoix; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

I. Forthwith after the passing of this Act it shall be lawful for all persons, proprietors of lands forming the beaches of the River St. Lawrence, in the Parishes of St. Pierre and St. Paul, called Baie St. Paul, in the said County of Charlevoix, to allow all geese, ducks, wild geese and other poultry frequenting the beaches, to go at large at all seasons of the year on such beaches, as far up as high water mark, without the permission of the owner or occupant of such beaches. Geese, &c may be allowed to stray on the beaches of St. Paul's Bay.

II. From the first day of September until the first day of December in each year, it shall be lawful for all proprietors of beach lands in the Parishes and County aforesaid, to allow all horses, mules, horned cattle, sheep, goats, pigs and other animals to go at large upon the said beaches, as far up as high water mark, without the permission of the other owners or occupants of the said beach lands. And other animals at certain seasons.

III. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
