An Act to provide for the Election of Reeves and Deputy Reeves by a direct vote of the Municipal Electors.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend chapter fifty-four of the Con-Preamble. solidated Statutes for Upper Canada, respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada, in so far as it relates to the election of Reeves and Deputy Reeves; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as 5 follows:

1. The Reeves and Deputy Reeves of Townships, Towns withdrawn Reeves and from the jurisdiction of the Council of the Counties in which they lie, Reeves to be and of incorporated Villages, shall, after the first day of January, one elected. thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, be such as shall be elected in

- 10 the manner hereinafter provided, by the electors entitled to vote for Councillors in such Townships, Towns, and incorporated Villages respectively; and the said electors shall, in addition to their votes for a Councillor or Councillors, vote for one candidate as Reeve (and, in the event of their being the requisite number of freeholders or householders
- 15 resident in such Township, Town, or incorporated Village, for one candidate as the Deputy Recve,) if there be more than one candidate for the said offices respectively.
- 2. Every qualified elector of Members of the Council shall be held Qualification to be qualified to be a candidate for and to hold the office of Reeve or of Reeves 20 Deputy Reeve.

3. On the first Monday in December next, and on the same day in Annual meetevery future year, at the hour of ten in the forenoon, the Clerk of the ing for the

Township, Town or incorporated Village shall preside at a public the election. meeting at such place as shall be appointed by the Council, to which all 25 the Municipal electors of the Township, Town, or incorporated Village shall have free access, and shall there receive the names of such persons as the said electors or any two of them may nominate as candidate for the offices of Reeve and Deputy Reeve respectively; and the candidates there and then nominated and duly qualified, and no others, shall be

30 eligible to be voted for and declared elected at the then next ensuing annual Municipal Election, and, if there be only one such candidate for either of the said offices, he shall be at once declared elected thereto.

4. All the provisions of chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Sta-Provisions of tutes for Upper Canada respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Con. Stat. U. Canada, which relate to the helding and conducting of elections for Mun. C., cap. 54, to 35 Canada, which relate to the holding and conducting of elections for Mu- apply. nicipal Councillors, shall apply, as far as they are applicable and consistent with this Act, to the election of Reeves and Deputies.

5. The returning officer (or, if the Municipality be divided into Return of wards, the returning officer for each ward) shall, within at least one week election to be 40 after the election, deliver a statement and certificate to the Clerk of the Council. Council, who shall, at the first meeting of the Council after the election,

exhibit the votes polled for the several candidates, if there be more than one candidate for either of the said offices, and thereupon the Council shall proceed to determine and declare who are duly elected to the offices of Reeve and Deputy Reeve respectively; and, in case there shall have been more than one candidate for the said offices respectively, the candidate duly qualified and having the greatest number of votes for either of the said offices, shall be declared duly elected. If there be only one qualified candidate for either office, he shall be declared elected; and, if there be no such candidate, the office shall be declared vacant and filled as hereinafter provided.

Reeves so elected to be members of their Councils. 6. The Reeves and Deputy Reeves so elected shall be Members of the Councils of the Municipalities in which they are respectively elected, and shall have the same powers and duties as Councillors elected to be Reeves and Deputy Reeves, respectively now have by law.

In case of vacancy.

7. In the case of a vacancy occurring in the office of Reeve or Deputy 15 Reeve, the Council of the Municipality shall, by a vote of the majority thereof, elect a Reeve or Deputy Reeve, as the circumstances may require, from among themselves, to fill the vacancy until a successor shall be duly elected at the next annual election.

Contrary previsions.

8. All the provisions of chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Sta-20 tutes for Upper Canada respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada, which conflict with or are contrary to the provisions of this Act, are hereby repealed.
