THE BRITISH ATTACK THE REBELS WITH SUCCESS.

ALEXANDRIA, Aug. 5.—The object of operations today was to reconnoitre in force. Commencing at 4 o'clock this afternoon a steady advance was made by the marines upon the railway line, the position upon the west bank of the Mahmoudieh canal, and the South Staffordshire regiment and mounted infantry upon the east bank.

The latter were completely silenced by the accurate fire of our forty pounder.
