Today, the global marketplace is changing, offering many opportunities for increased sales of Canadian agriculture and food products abroad. Agricultural exports are extremely important for the Canadian agri-food sector, with a value representing roughly 50 per cent of gross farm receipts. These exports have more significance for the Canadian economy than most other major agri-food exporting nations.

Trade Commissioners abroad can:

- promote your company to local customers;
- advise on marketing channels;
- recommend appropriate trade fairs;
- identify suitable foreign firms to act as your agent;

- help you find credit and business information on potential foreign partners;
- intercede to help solve problems with duties, taxes or foreign exchange;
- advise you on a country's trade, business and financial environment and practices;
- advise and assist you with foreign joint ventures and licensing.

It is recommended that you develop a systematic marketing plan and contact only those Trade Commissioners in your target market area. For help in developing your plan, contact your nearest International Trade Centre. There's one in your province.
