PROVING OF THE ESTIMATES Works Committee Chops a Few Thousand Dollars From Figures of Engineer Rust.

A special meeting of the Works Committee was held yesterday afternoon for the purpose of verifying the estimates. As a result of the contest, \$41,000 were chopped off the general estimates of the Engineer's department, leaving the total to be slashed by the Board of Control at \$302,000.

Under the head of engineering and expenses, Mr. Rust asked for \$23,000 for salaries. This is \$2,000 more than was spent for this purpose last year.

Regarding an item of \$500 for repairs to plank walks, Ald. Hubbard said it used to amount to \$25,000, and the reduction was a tribute to the policy of laying concrete sidewalks.

When the item of \$83,000 for scavenging was discussed, the Engineer proposed that the Street Commissioner decline to remove ashes from churches, educational institutions, factories and wholesale houses.

There was an item of \$18,000 for asphalt repairs, and Ald. Hubbard said it was a good argument for the city having an asphalt plant.

The item of \$500 for new stables in the north end was passed after Ald. Stewart had said it was cruel to leave a horse in the present quarters here.

The waterworks estimates came in for some serious consideration, and Ald. Spence wondered why the Engineer had not included several big items in the bylaw, which was submitted to the people at the late election.

The committee decided that the Parks and Exhibition Committee should take hold of Reservoir Park as it was unfair to have the whole expense of its maintenance charged to the waterworks. It was a public park and should be cared for as other parks.

The items taken out of the waterworks estimates which it was expected would be embodied in a bylaw, included \$25,000 for concreting the Reservoir Reservoir. The amount asked for this was \$35,000, but \$10,000 will be asked from the general rate to provide for emergency.
