HEEDING THE INVITATION

"A certain man made a great supper, and invited many. And he sent his servant, at the hour of supper, to say to them that were invited that they should come, for now all things are ready." (Luke xiv, 16, 17.)

The Lord is reasonable in His demands—yes, reasonable to the extent of generosity. He never asks of us anything except for which He intends to pay us a hundredfold.

From this fact we should learn the beauty of God's orders and the sweetness of His invitations. We should notice how in His parables, as the one in today's Gospel, He invites us to labor in His vineyard.

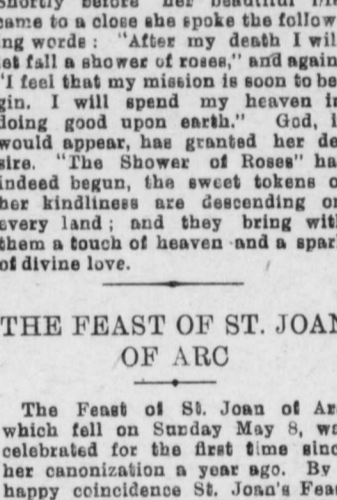

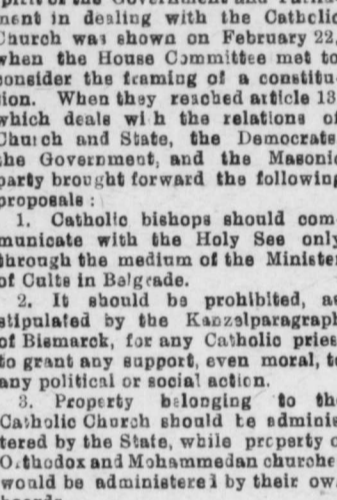
