THE APPROACHING CENSUS. The census which is to be taken by the Government early in April will be, without a doubt, the most complete that has ever been taken in Canada.

(1) Dwelling-houses inhabited, uninhabited, building; vessels; shanties; families with names, age, sex, place of birth, religion, profession, occupation, condition (married or widowed) going to school, deaf and dumb, blind, insane.

(2) Deaths within twelve months—Name, sex, age, religion, country of birth, occupation, married or widowed, month and cause of death.

(3) Real Estate—Total of acres owned; number of village or town lots owned; number of dwellings owned; ditto of warehouses, stores, factories, shops, etc.; number of barns and stables owned.

(4) Cultivated Lands—Owner, tenant, employee; total of acres; number of acres improved; number in pasture, gardens, orchards, field products—Full details. Plants, fruits, etc.—Full details.

(5) Live Stock—Horses over three years old, colts and fillies, yearling oxen, milch cows, other horned cattle, sheep, swine; colts, sheep killed or sold for slaughter; wool, yards of home-made cloth, flannel and linen.

(6) Forest Products—Square pine, cubic feet; tamarac, birch, maple, hickory, walnut; spruce and other logs, spars and masts, thousands of staves; cords of lath wood; tan-bark, fire wood.

(7) Shipping—Steam—Number of shares owned; tonnage owned. Sail—ditto. Barges—ditto. Fishing vessels—Full particulars of catch.

(8) Minerals—Full particulars of product.
