

An exchange says: We have found

from chapped hands in the winter found from our own experience that potatoes are very watery from the month of March till the market offers us new ones. In our kitchen we overcome the songy disposition of these valuable vegetables by soaking them as few hours in cold water, and putting them into hot water to boil, without salt; then when they are tender nearly all the way through turn the water off, and refill the sance, pan with cold water. Put in salt and boil till they are quite done; drain off that water also, cover as tightly as possible, and set on back of the range, to steam, lifting the cover for an instant once or twice; then, with one hand holding dewn the lid, shake the saucepan gently, quickly and steadily for a moment, and serve your potatoes hot. If rightly maneged they will be like snow-balls.
