March 18 has two German officials landed on the southwest coast of the big island of New Britain to explore the island.

On the morning of March 18 a sound was heard at Finckhaven as of distant thunder. A few minutes later the sea roared from the shore in an unbroken manner, and revealed to view, six feet above its surface, a reef at the harbor entrance that had never been seen above water before.

Two days later the little vessel Ostia, sent from Finckhaven, reached the south coast of New Britain, eight miles from the coast.

This wave, judged from its effects, is believed to have been about forty feet high. All the villages that were on the beach had disappeared. For ten or twelve miles along the coast a belt of stunted bushes three-quarters of a mile wide had been swept away.
