HELPS IN STUDYING.

INTRODUCTORY. The angel probably appeared to Joseph immediately after the wise men had departed, for Herod would expect their return and make enquiries without delay, if they did not come to him. It was necessary that the family should get so far away from Bethlehem that they could not be traced easily, should the king search for them. Herod died about the passover in B C 4, therefore the flight must have occurred in February. This agrees with what was said last Sabbath in regard to the time of the wise men's visit. The stay in Egypt was very brief, for Joseph had not heard who Herod's successor was when he returned.
