**THE DISCOVERY OF AN EARLY RIBBER TESTER.**

Frederick Tischer's Fall of Fourteen Feet - The End of a Heavy Drinker's Life - Suffering from a Nervous System - A Tragic Tragedy.

At 8:30 o'clock yesterday morning, while a gas work was going on down Ontario street, he found the almost dead body of a man lying on the sidewalk opposite No. 12. He happened at the door of the place, which is a boarding house kept by Miss Eliza McArthur, and immediately the lady called out. They identified the body as that of Frederick Tischer, who for four years had been employed as a gas fitter in the city. For two years past he had boarded with Miss McArthur.
