The revised schedules were distributed on Friday last. They place the County of Huron and the Town of Goderich in a rather better position than before. Under the first schedule Huron did not receive its fair share of the railway allowance, but thanks to the representations of our friends, A. M. Hess, Esq., County Treasurer, the matter has been rectified and Huron instead of \$197,060 pays \$244,000.
