Provincial Rifle Association of Nova Scotia.

RULES AS AMENDED, 1867.

1. The Association shall consist of all persons paying ten shillings per annum, or a donation of five pounds, to the Provincial Rifle Association.

2. Any county Regiment subscribing not less than Five Pounds, annually, to the funds of the Provincial Rifle Association, shall be considered as being in connection with it, and shall be entitled to a number of memberships of Non-commissioned Officers and Men in the proportion of one to every eight shillings and fourpence thus subscribed.

3. Volunteer Companies whose effective strength is over 60 and paying to the Association Ten Dollars per annum, shall be entitled to send six members to the competition. Volunteer Companies whose effective strength is under 60 and paying eight dollars, shall be entitled to send five members. No Volunteer Officer not being a subscriber to the Association will be allowed to compete.

4. All subscriptions from County Regiments shall be paid through the Commanding Officer of their respective regiments.

5. The affairs of the Association shall be under the control of a Council, consisting *ex officio* of the Secretary and Treasurer for the time being, and also of not less than Fifteen Members nor more than Twenty, fifteen of whom shall be elected annually by ballot at the general meeting, and five subsequently by the Council—five to form a quorum.

6. The Annual meeting of the Members of the Association for the election of a Council and other matters shall be some time during the month of February or March in each year, at such time and place as the President and Council may deem most suitable.

7. The Council shall meet quarterly, or oftener, if required by any two of its members, and keep minutes of its proceedings. It shall have power to elect new members, to fill up any vacancy in the Council, and to appoint the Treasurer and Secretary, and shall be regulated in their proceedings by such rules or bye-laws as may from time to time be enacted by them for the regulation of all matters committed to its

charge, subject to the approval of the Commander-in-Chief on all subjects of a purely military character.

8. There shall be a Patron and Vice Patrons, named by the Council.

9. The Council shall choose from the members elected, a President, who shall be President of the Association.

10. There shall be Vice-Presidents. The Senior Militia Officers of Counties (not being unattached), who are subscribers, shall be *ex officio* Vice-Presidents. Should the Senior Officer not be a subscriber, the next in rank, being a subscriber shall fill the office.

11. The prizes of the Association shall be open to the Local Forces of the Province of Nova Scotia (being subscribers), on such terms, and at such times and places as may be fixed by the Council.

12. All competitors for prizes (except for the all-comers' prize) shall be required to appear in the uniform of their respective corps, and shall be certified by their Commanding Officers to be efficient in Manual and Platoon and such other military exercises as may be ordered by the Commander-in-Chief.

13. Ties shall be decided by the highest score in marks obtained at the longest range in the competition; if still a tie, then by the greatest number of hits at the same range; if still a tie, then by the application of the same rule to the next longest range, and so on with any other range in the competition; and the present Bye-Law for the firing off of ties shall only be resorted to when these means have all been exhausted.

14. A ticket—not transferable—shall be issued by the Secretary, to each subscriber and competitor, which being delivered to a squad commander, directed to by the officer in charge of the field, any time before the first round at the first range of any competition is completed, shall entitle the holder to fire at such competition.

15. Any County Rifle Association subscribing not less than ten dollars annually to the funds of the Provincial Rifle Association, shall be considered as being in connexion with it, and shall be entitled to a membership in the proportion of one to every 8s. 4d. thus subscribed.

16. All subscriptions from County Rifle Associations shall be paid through the Presidents of their respective Associations.

17. The President of any County Rifle Association in connexion with the Provincial Rifle Association, and being a member thereof, shall be *ex officio* a member of Council.

BYE-LAWS.

1. An Umpire shall be appointed by the Council. All disputed points shall be decided by the Umpire, whose decision shall be final.

2. An Officer shall be appointed to take command of all who may assemble to compete for the prizes, and maintain order and discipline on the field.

3. The size of targets to be used shall be the same as laid down in the Army Musquetry Regulations. Bull's Eyes to count 4. Centres 3. Outers 2.

4. TIES.—1. Where prizes are competed for at *one* range only, ties shall fire *one* shot each at that range until the best shot be returned. 2. Where prizes are competed at more than one range ties shall fire *one* shot at the longest range until the best shot be returned.

5. None but Government ammunition, supplied on the ground from the Association, shall be used. Any competitor (except for the all-comers prizes) infringing this rule shall be disqualified from competing for any prizes during the remainder of the meeting.

6. Any competitor discharging his rifle without having previously obtained permission from the Officer in command of the field, or of the Squad Commander, shall be fined two dollars, and in default of payment, be disqualified for competing for any prizes during the remainder of the meeting.

7. The squads shall be formed as directed by the officer in command of the field, and competitors will not be allowed to change their squad, throughout the meeting, after having been once placed.

8. Volunteers and Militia allowed to compete in full or undress uniform.

INSTRUCTIONS TO REGISTER KEEPERS

To parade in front of Secretary's tent at half past eight o'clock every morning for orders.

To take post before the commencement of the firing at each range, at the rallying post first chosen, and to draw for targets.

To march the squad directly to firing point of target drawn.

To enter rank, name, corps, and number of ticket correctly from the ticket.

Not to let any one shoot without he gives up his ticket.

To maintain silence at firing point.

To call "cease firing" in a loud tone whenever the danger flag is shown at any of the butts.

To call out distinctly before commencement of firing the distance and number of target.

To call competitors in regular order to fire.

To call out result of each shot before recording it.

To mark out any error, and enter correct figure on the same line in column of remarks, and at foot of register to note the number of such corrections.

Not to total the scores of retired competitors.

To read aloud the totals at the conclusion of the firing of each rank at each range.

To take every precaution that no time is unnecessarily lost between the shots.

To see that the "Regulations for firing" are adhered to.

To sign the register.

Not to enter into any dispute but at once to refer any doubtful point to the Range Officer.

Not to allow any but officers in authority to see the register.

To deliver the register to the Secretary at the close of each competition or day.

REPORT.

THE COUNCIL, in submitting their Annual Report for 1866, refer with satisfaction to the following statements, which show a more healthy financial condition than that of last year—that the interest taken in the Association is rapidly extending among the members of the local forces, and that the effect of these annual matches is largely to increase the number of efficient marksmen as well as to produce a higher degree of skill in the use of the Rifle.

The Report of 1865 exhibited an indebtedness by the Association of eighty dollars over the receipts of that year, which sum was afterwards increased by the addition of some accounts which had not been rendered at the time that report was made up. Out of the receipts of the past year these liabilities have been liquidated; all the current expenses paid; Prizes to the value of nearly \$1,800 awarded to the successful competitors; £20 sterling remitted to the National Rifle Association of England; a supply of stores on hand nearly sufficient for another year, and the sum of \$417.95 deposited in the Provincial Savings Bank, to the credit of the Association.

Owing to the very wet weather which preceded the meeting at Bedford, and which had retarded the harvests throughout the country, many persons were prevented from attending.

The list of subscribers was increased by the addition of 96 names, and numbers at present 380.

The number of competitors was largely in excess of 1865; some of the competitions, indeed, showing nearly 100 more names.

The table of comparisons of shooting indicates a decided

improvement: twenty-five of the best shots in five competitions—all that could be compared—having scored an average of 7.60 over the same numbers in the same competitions in 1865; and the general average of all who completed the requisite number of rounds in both years, also stood at a higher figure this year. This fact is more worthy of notice because the number of competitors was nearly as five to three. It is, therefore, evident that there must have been a great deal of home practice, which it is the object of this Association to encourage.

The Council had a Pool Target erected for those ruled out, and for casual visitors. If four such targets were erected at the next match, they would find employment, and if properly conducted would be a source of profit as well as amusement.

During the match the attention of the Council was called to the fact that one of the competitors was firing with a plugged trigger. The President immediately went to the squad, and having satisfied himself that the statement was correct, summarily dismissed the man who had thus violated one of the bye-laws of the Association, and adopted a very dangerous and dishonourable expedient, and at the same time disqualified him from further competition, and from any interest he might have had in any prize.

All the counties of the Province represented, succeeded in obtaining a fair proportion of the Prizes awarded, as will appear on reference to the published proceedings of the year.

The Council would suggest the propriety of obtaining some badge or mark of distinction to be worn by winners of the Gold Medal of the Association, and of the Cogswell and Ladies' Cups. If adopted, this privilege should be retrospective, so as to entitle any winner to wear the badge of the prize previously held by him.

It would be advisable to import from England four double-barreled fowling pieces, and two silver watches, to be given as prizes at the next match. Also a good Telescope,

capable of discerning a bullet mark on a target at 1,000 yards.

The long interval which elapses between the termination of the Bedford match, and the Annual Meeting of the Association, has heretofore led to the report of one year being published with the detail of the shooting of the next year ; this is objectionable and should be remedied.

Donors of prizes would confer a favour by not confining their prizes to any portion of the competitors, as the exclusion of any of the members excites dissatisfaction ; and the Association as its name denotes, is designed to be *Provincial*.

Prizes limited to any class, should be competed for at the termination of the regular match.

By establishing a competition, using the same targets, as at Wimbledon, correct comparison could be made between the averages obtained there and at Bedford—which, though very desirable, is at present impossible.

As it is generally desired that the annual match terminate in a single week, and in time for the competitors to return home by the afternoon train of Saturday, the Council would suggest the adoption of the following regulations :

1. That ties be decided by the highest score in marks obtained at the longest range in the competition ; if still a tie then by the greatest number of hits at the same range ; if still a tie, then by the application of the same rule to the next longest range, and so on with any other range in the competition ; and that the present By-Law for the firing off of ties be only resorted to when these means have all been exhausted.

2. That a ticket—not transferable—be issued by the Secretary, to each subscriber and competitor, which being delivered to a squad commander, directed to him by the officer in charge of the field, any time before the first round at the first range at any competition is completed, shall entitle the holder to fire at such competition. The time lost in calling the roll will thus be obviated, and the squad com-

manders have no difficulty in correctly recording the name and rank of each person in his squad.

In July last Lt.-Colonel Belcher resigned the office of Secretary and Treasurer, which the Council very much regretted, as they were thereby deprived of the services of an experienced and efficient officer. Captain Thomson, of the 1st Brigade Halifax Militia Artillery, was thereupon elected to fill the offices thus vacated.

The Council are particularly indebted to His Excellency Sir W. F. Williams, for the interest manifested by him in the welfare of the Association, and also for a valuable Gold Watch and Chain.

The Ladies of Nova Scotia, always foremost in every good work, have again contributed handsomely to the funds of the Association.

The Council record with pleasure the establishment by his Worship the Mayor, and members of the City Council of Halifax, of a "City Prize." Unfortunately the wording of the resolution granting this was capable of a double construction; and a question raised just as the firing was about to commence, was decided not as afterwards appeared was intended. This misapprehension the Council very much regret.

The Council have again to record their obligation to Colonel Laurie, I. F. O. M., for valuable services on the Field, as Umpire, and also another handsome prize. To the other donors and friends of the Association, the Council desire to convey their sincere thanks, for their contributions and countenance.

The Council record with pleasure the kindness displayed by Colonel Nugent, when handing over the Camp, and the evident desire on his part to do all in his power to promote the comfort of its temporary occupants.

The Council have again to record their obligation to Colonel Sinclair, Adj.-General Militia, for the interest he continues to take in furthering the objects of the Association, and for the material aid his position and inclination have en-

abled him to grant. Captain Breckin, D. A. Q. M. G. M., and the staff under his command, discharged their arduous duties in a highly satisfactory manner.

The warm interest and great care manifested by Mr. de-Balinhard, Instructor of Musquetry, 47th Regt., in charge during the match, elicited deserved praise from the competitors; and the Council record with satisfaction their appreciation of his continued watchfulness and unremitting efforts, by day and night, to prevent accidents, and insure the success of the meeting.

In concluding this report, the Council regret the entire absence from the list of donors to the Association, of the names of the moneyed men of the city and country, not directly connected with the local forces of the Province; and also the fact that not a single Banking institution, or other wealthy corporation, in any way contributed to the funds of the Association. It does appear strange that they should in this instance be so regardless of their own interests; for it is evident that the efficiency of the local force for defence, must more directly affect them than any other portion of the community.
