THE L.A.W. AND COLORED CYCLISTS

Barred by the Constitution, But a Fight Will be Made for Admission.

Philadelphia, Pa., Dec. 25.—It is reported in local cycling circles that an effort will be made at the coming meeting of the national assembly of the League of American Wheelmen to have the constitution so changed as to admit colored cyclists.

Some few years ago the question of admitting colored riders caused a great stir in the cycling world, and, in fact, time near causing a split in the league. There was nothing in the constitution against the admission of negro riders, but the Southern members threatened to withdraw from the league if colored people were admitted.

There is a general feeling among the members of the L.A.W. that the time has come when the league should admit colored riders. The city, the league men argue that the very best class of colored riders is in cycling, and that the organization should admit them, thus giving them the same protection received by other wheelmen.

It is expected that the colored riders will make a hard fight for recognition this year, and it is asserted that they will be successful in their battle.

PROTECTION AND PROSPERITY.

Free trade has had an experience of fifty years in Great Britain. No one denies that England has prospered during that period, especially during the first half of it. Until recently the cause of this prosperity has been attributed almost wholly to the adoption of free trade. Latterly this theory has been questioned. To-day it can be disproved. Free trade has not been the cause of England's commercial supremacy. While free trade was undoubtedly one of the conditions that prevailed during the past fifty years of English progress, it was not the only condition. There were numerous other conditions and these contributed more to the expansion of English trade than the principle of free trade. As a matter of fact economic writers of repute are prepared to prove that the development of the trade, manufactures and commerce of Great Britain during the last fifty years would have been greater if the protective regime had been continued. One of the most interesting features of a volume, entitled "Protection and Prosperity," recently sent to The World, is the history of Great Britain, France, Russia, and the other European countries. The author is Geo. B. Curtis, an American lawyer, residing at Binghamton, N.Y. The industrial history of England is written for the first time from a protectionist point of view. The facts cited by the writer and the conclusions he deduces therefrom will open the eyes of Englishmen. The work is probably the best practical exposé of the fallacy of free trade that has ever been published. It gives a history of the tariff legislation of Germany, France, Russia, and the other European countries. It shows that protection has been the studied policy of the whole of them, Great Britain alone excepted, during the last half century. The author shows that the only loss of free trade principles for any considerable length of time, by a civilized and great producing nation, is to be found in Great Britain. Other European countries have, for short periods, reduced duties on imports and approached a revenue basis, but they all soon returned to a protective system. The beneficial effects of free trade in the one country where it has had a fair trial are graphically pointed out. The author shows that free trade has been a failure in England, that it is responsible for England's decreasing exports and increasing imports in almost every branch of trade. The vigorous protective system of Germany is strikingly contrasted with the free trade regime in Great Britain. Under protection Germany has made rapid strides, while under free trade, when Great Britain, under free trade, has been losing ground. Never was the principle of protection more generally approved of than it is to-day. We in Canada have weakened a little on the theory for the present, but as the author says, "there is no middle or neutral ground between the policies of protection and free trade," and the attempt of the present Government to give the country a sort of incidental protective and revenue tariff at the same time will soon be repudiated. A tariff that is neither the one thing nor the other is like lukewarm water. It will be spewed out. There is no neutral ground between the two policies. The World believes that protection is beneficial to a country from the moment it is applied, believe in an aggressive and uncompromising policy of protection. We believe in protecting Canada with just such a tariff as the United States proposes to adopt, under the McKinley regime. The battle of protection will have to be fought over again in Canada. Even the late Government failed to do adequate justice to this great underlying principle of national prosperity. Canada of all countries needs a stiff protective tariff. The prospect of a tariff points to a period of expansion and prosperity in the Dominion. By limiting imports we increase our production and therefore increase our population. Protection will bring two to the country for every one that would come to us under free trade. The work we have referred to is published by the Pan-American Publishing Company, 111 Fifth Avenue, New York. We commend it to everyone in Canada who is interested in the welfare of the country. "Protection and Prosperity" is a text book that should be in the hands of every Canadian statesman and public man.

THE ST. LAWRENCE CANALS.

What policy is the Government going to pursue in regard to the completion of the St. Lawrence canal improvements? That is a question the country would like to hear answered. Millions of capital invested in our canal system have been unproductive for many long years because of the delay in completing the work. The great sums spent on the Welland Canal will return us no equivalent until the St. Lawrence system is deepened to fourteen feet. This work should be rushed through with the utmost speed. Many enterprises will be started as soon as we have a 14-foot channel from Lake Superior to Montreal. Toronto will be greatly benefited by the completion of the improvements. There ought to be a profitable interchange of Ontario produce for Nova Scotia bituminous coal. There is no reason why Ontario should import coal from coal after the St. Lawrence system is deepened to 14 feet. The vessels which

SHOT BY HER HUSBAND.

Mrs. Meahan Asked Her Husband for Money to Buy Christmas Toys and Received a Bullet.

"Wait a few minutes, I'll give you money."

Meahan went to the living apartments upstairs, and when he came down, instead of money, there was a six-barrelled revolver in his hand. His aim was rather unsteady, but he said he had made up his mind to kill his wife.

This caused Mrs. Meahan to scream, and she asked her husband to spare her life for their children's sake. The drunken man, however, was not to be deterred, and when Mrs. Meahan saw that her pleadings were only angering her husband, she started to run from the store.

She opened the door on the small piazza, and just as she was descending the steps a pistol shot rang out. Some passer-by heard the noise and saw Mrs. Meahan fall down the front steps. As she did not move, she was thought to have been killed.
