NO MORE FAILURES AND A READER MARKET.

New York, May 17. - Hardly a vestige of the excitement of Wednesday, Thursday and Friday remained on Wall street to-day.

Money has been close all day, notwithstanding the action of the clearing house, and one national bank made a loan of \$25,000 at fifteen per cent.

Whatever feeling of suspicion may have been aroused by the Wall street disturbances was so far abated that where lines of depositors appeared yesterday to draw their money they reappeared to-day to deposit it again.

The receiver of the Newark savings institution submitted a statement to the chancellor, showing the amount due depositors to be \$1,166,634.
