Province of New-Brunswick, in America, have by their petition to our trufty and well beloved THOMAS CARLETON; Efquire, our Governor and Commander in Chief in and over our faid province, reprefented that they have, by their exertions, conquered many of the difficulties attending the fettlement of a new country; and that they are anxious to remove the remaining evils they at prefent labour under, part of which flow from the want of a regular Magifiracy for the able and orderly government of the diffricts they inhabit : AND WHEREAS they have also reprefented; that they humbly conceive one important flep towards this defirable end, would be granting them a Charter of Incorporation; under the fanction of which they might he enabled to ordain fuch bye-laws and regulations as their peculiar wants and rapid growth urgently call for a That the advantages to be derived from a charter, empowering them to eftablish fuch ordinances as are requifite for the good government of a populous place are to obvious, they think it neceffary conly to hint at them; but that the fpeedy admipifiration of juffice both civil and criminal, will be to greatly, the by the erefling a Mayor's Court and Quarter Seffions, they humping the bore this confideration alone will be fufficient to induce a compliance with their requeft; and have confidently promifed that their prudent use of the liberties fo to be granted them will julify the favour. AND WHEREAS our faid loving fubjects, impelled by the foregoing reafons, have humbly petitioned the faid TROMAS CARLETON, Elquire, dur Governor aforefaid, for a Chartercomprehending the faid diffricts on both fides of the river Saint John, creft

NOW therefore know ye, That having taken the fame into our Royal con-fideration, and being willing, as well for the reafons above fet forth as for divers other good caufes and confiderations us moving, to comply with the reafonable request and humble petition of our faid loving fubjects, of ou efpecial grace, certain knowledge and mere motion, we have given and granted, and by these presents for us, our heirs and fucceffors, do give and grant unto our faid loving fubjects the inhabitanta of the faid dif-tricts, as they are hereby united, that the faid diffricts, and all the lands and waters thereto adjoining orrunning in, by or through the fame, bounded by a line to commonce and beginning near Fort-Howe, at Portland Point, at low water mark, and thence running a direct line to a finall point or ledge of land at the caufey by the old faw mill, thence caft north east until a direct line shall strike the creek running through Hazen's marsh on the east fide of the eastern diffrict aforefaid, thence along the course of the faid creek to its mouth, thence by a line running fouth nineteen degrees welt into the bay, until it meets a line running east from the fouth point of Partridge Island, and along the faid line to the faid point, thence by a direct line to the point on the fhore which is at the fouth east extremity of a line running fouth forty-two degrees east from the river Saint John to the bay of Fundy, and terminating the town lots of the wekern diffrift aforefaid, thence along the faid line north forty-two degrees weft to the river Saint John aforefaid, and continuing the faid course across the faid river until it meets the opposite thore, and from thence along thenorth flore of the faid river at low water mark to Portland-Point aforefaid, and every part and parcel thereof, are and shall forever hereafter be a City incorporate of a Mayor, a Recorder, fix Aldermen and fix Affiliants, by the name of, THE CITY OF SAINT JOHN. And the faid diffricts and every part thereof, as well the land as the water, and the land covered with water, within the lines, limits and boundaries aforefaid, a City incorporate in Right and Name, by the name of, THE CITY OF SAME Joux, we do really and fully create, make, ordain, conflitute, declare Name of the body and confirm by these prefents. And further of our especial grace we have given, granted, ordained, conflituted, appointed and declared, and by these presents, for us, and our heirs and fucceffors, do give, grant, ordain, confittute, appoint and declare, that the Inhabitants of the faid city of Saint John, and the Mayor, Recorder, Aldermen, and Affiftants thereof; are, and from henceforth forever hereafter shall be one body corporate and polltic in deed, fact and name, by the name of, THE MAYOR, ALDERNER AND COMMONALTY OF THE CITY OF SAINT JOHN; and them by the name of the Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the city of Saint John, we do really and fully create, make, ordain, conftitute, appoint and declare, by these presents; and that by the name of the Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the city of Saint John, they may have perpetual fucceffion. And that they and their fucceffors forever by the name of the Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the city of Saint John, be and forever hereafter shall be perfons able and in law capable to have, get, receive, take, poffefs and enjoy, houfes, lands, tenements, rents, reversions, remainders, royalties, franchifes, jurifdictions, pre-eminences. immunities and hereditaments, to them and their fucceffors in fee fimple, or for term of life or lives or years or otherwife, and alfo goods and chattels, and all other things whatfoever whether real, perfonal or mixt : and alfo to give, grant, let, fet, or affign the fame or any part thereof; and to do and execute all other things in and about the fame, as they shall think necessary, fit, or good for

for the benefit and advantage of the faid city and the inhabitants thereof : And also that they be and forever shall be perform able and in law capable to fue and be fued, plead and be impleaded, anfwer and be infwered unto, defend and be defended, before us, our heirs and facesflow, and in all or any of our courts of law and equity, and other places whatfoever, and before our orany of our judges, juffices, minifers, and other perfon and perfona whatfoever, in all and all manner of actions, fuite, complaints, demands, pleas, caufes and matters whatfoever, in as full and ample menner as any other perfon or perfons whatfoever, being perfons able and in law capa-ble may fue and be fued, plead and be impleaded, anfwer and be anfwered unto, defend and be defended, by any lawful ways or means whatfoever ; and that they and their fucceffors forever fhall have a Common Seal, Shall have a Common to ferve for the enfealing of all and fingular their grants, deeds, conveyances, contracts, bonds, articles of agreements, afignments, powers and warrants of attorney, and all and fingular their affairs and things touching or concerning the faid Corporation ; and the fame feal they shall have power from time to time, as they shall "think proper, to break, change, alter and new make, fo as that at the fame time there doth not exift any more than one Common Seal for the purposes aforefaid.

And further we do ordain and appoint by thefe prefents, that for the Shall be divided into better government of the faid city, the fame shall forever hereafter be and remain divided into fix wards, in the following manner, to wit, four of the faid wards which thall be on the east fide of the faid harbour thall be feparated from the other two which lie on the western fide thereof, by a line to be sun through the middle of the faid harbour and of the bay at the entrance of the fame: (1) And the faid four wards on the eaftern fide of the faid harbour, shall be separated from each other by a fouth line commencing at the north end of the faid city in the middle of Sidney-fireet, and to run fouth through the middle of the faid fireet, and to continue the fame courfe into the bay until it comes to the line of the limits of the faid city ; and by a line east and west to be run and continued through the middle of Duke-fireet until it reaches the middle of the harbour aforefaid on the weft fide of the faid four wards, and until it comes to the line of the eaflern' li-And the faid two wards on the weftern fide of the mita of the faid city. faid harbour shall be separated from each other by a direct line to be run from the line terminating the town lots on the fouth weft lim is, and continued through the middle of Rodney-freet until it reaches the Middle of the harbour aforefaid. And we do further ordain that the north wen ward on the call fide of the faid harbour fhall forever be called King's Ward; and that the fouth weft ward on the east fide of the faid harbour thall be forever called Queen's Ward; and that the north eafl ward on the eafl fide of the faid harbour shall be forever called Sidney Ward ; and that the fouth east ward on the east fide of the faid harbour shall be forever called Duke Ward ; and that the westermost ward on the west fide of the faid "harbour shall forever be called Guy's Ward ; and that the easiermost ward of the faid weft fide of the harbour shall forever be called Brook's Ward.

[1] By the Prov. Stat. 43 Geo. 3, c. 3, the four wurds on the custorn side of the harbour are divided by lines drawn from the hurbour to the rear of the city through the centre of King's street, Duke street, and Staint James and Stormont-street; and by the same Statute, that part of the city lying to the northward of King's street, is to be forever called and known by the name of King's Ward; and that part between King's street and Duke-street, is to be forever culled and known by the name of Queen's Ward ; and that part between Dake-street and Saint James and Stormont Street, is to be forever called and known by the name of Duke's Ward; and the residue thereof, lying to the southward of Saint James and Starmontistreet, is to be forever called and known by the name of SiJney Ward.

And for the better execution of our will, gift and grant in this behalf, we have affigned, named, conflituted and made, and by these presents for us, our heirs and fucceffors, do affign, name, conflitute and make our trufty and well beloved GABAIRL G. Luptow, Elquire, one of our Council for our faid province of New-Brunfwick, to be the prefent Mayor of the fame city, to do and execute all. things which unto the office of Mayor of our faid city doth or may belong or in any wife appertain ; to continue, and be continued in, and to execute the faid office of Mayor until another fit perfon shall be appointed and fworn in the faid office. And we do moreover, for us, our heirs and fucceffors, give and grant unto the faid Mayor and his fucceffors, and to the Mayor of the faid . city for the time being, and to each of them forever, full power and authority to depute and appoint the Recorder of the faid city for the time being, in the place of the Mayor of the faid city, for the time being, and as his deputy in all matters and refpcets to act and do all things which to the office of the Mayor of the faid city, within the limits, liberties and precincts thereof, do or ought to belong, during the fickness or in the absence of the faid Mayor, for the time being. And we do hereby will and grant, that every fuch Recorder, fo to be deputed and appointed, after taking fuch oath as herein after is directed for every fuch deputy to take, shall have as full power and authority to act and do, in the fickness or absence of the Mayor of the faid city for the time being, all and fingular those things which to the office of Mayor of the faid city belong or shall belong or appertain, to all intents and purpoles as the Mayor of the faid city, for the time being, by virtue of these prefents, or otherwise, hath, shall or ought to have. And we do further for us, our heirs and fucceffors, will, ordain and grant, that in cafe it fhall to happen that the faid prefent Mayor of the faid city, or any of his fucceffors, or any of the Mayors of the faid city for the time being, shall die, before any other fit perfon shall be appointed and fworn Mayor of the faid city in their respective rooms and places, then in every fuch cafe, upon the death of fuch Mayor, fuch Recorder for the time being, who shall have been to appointed and fworn to act in the place of or as deputy to fuch Mayor, shall be and is hereby appointed and declared Mayor of the faid city, and to continue and be continued in, and to exccute the fame office of Mayor of the faid city, from the death of fuch Mayor fo dying, until another fit perfon shall be appointed and fworn Mayor of the faid city, in fuch manner as in and by these presents is hereaster disected for the faid Mayor of the faid city, to be appointed and lworn ; and fo as often as fuch cafe fhall happen ; which acceffion of the faid Recorder to the office of Mayor of the faid city, shall not operate as a sus persedeas to the authority or committion of the Recorder of the faid city, but the faid Recorder shall hold, exercise and enjoy, as well the office of Mayor as the office of Recorder of the faid city, until another fit perfon be appointed and fworn Mayor of the faid city.

And further we have affigned, ordained, named and conflituted and by thefe prefents for us, our heirs, and fucceffors, do affign, ordain, name and conflitute our well beloved WAAD CUIPMAN, Efquire, to be the prefent Recorder of the faid city, to do and execute all things which unto the office of Recorder of the faid city do or may belong or in any manner appertain, aud to continue and be continued in and exercife the faid office of Recorder, until another fit perfon fhall be appointed and fworn in the faid office. And further we have named, ordained and conflituted, and by thefe prefents for us, our heirs and fucceffors do ordain and conflitute our beloved *Bartholomew Crannell*, Efquire, to be the prefent Clerk of the faid city, who fhall be, and be called, the Common Clerk of the faid city.
