CHRISTIAN FRIENDS,

In presenting to you the Annual Report of the Primitive Methodist Missionary Society in Canada, the Committee desires to acknowledge its deep sense of obligation to God for the degree of prosperity He has vouchsafed to the missions under its care, and to the numerous friends and supporters, for the increased aid rendered the past year.

We rejoice that other missionary organizations are putting forth efforts for the conversion of mankind, and that men and money are being offered on the missionary altar, to enable them to respond to Macedonian cries that come from far and near. Yet we ask, could not much more be done for God, for Christ, and for souls?—could not much larger sums of money be presented to Heaven's shrine?—could not a far greater number of men, constrained by the love of Christ and the love of man, devote themselves to the promotion of the God-appointed enterprise?—and could not we do more than we have been wont, to push on the ark of the Lord through the earth?

Taking up the statistics of the world, the prospect seems vast and astounding. We are told that the population of the globe is about one thousand two hundred and twenty-five millions! Romanism and the Greek Church have two hundred and thirty millions, and Protestantism enrolls eighty millions. Out of the eighty millions, about fifteen millions only are recorded as professing members of Protestant Churches. Now, if this statistical account be formidable and discouraging, the geographical view is calculated to inspire hope. Protestant mission efforts have access to China and Siam, and are invading Southern Asia, through India and Madagascar: they have passed westward, and penetrated South Western Africa, and on to the north, through Algiers: they are in Egypt, all along the coast of the Levant, and into the interior, among the Nestorians. Mediterranean, they are in Turkey, Greece, and Italy. All the North American Continent is won; South America is opening its doors; and the fifth division of the globe, Oceanica, has been the scene of glorious triumphs of the different missionary bodies.

The watchmen that man the walls of Zion are ringing out the silvery tones of the gospel trumpet to the nations of every hue of skin and height of stature. Our own denominational missionary efforts are found principally in Great Britain and Ireland, in Canada, in Australia, and the Western States of America. The missionary income last year of the Parent Society was £14,582 13s. 8d. sterling. Now as this cause is essentially missionary from its origin, as it was born in a revival of religion, revivals and expansion by missionary operations are necessary to its life, in order that it may go onwards, multiplying itself. If there should come any pause or cessation of Missionary effort, the rapid decay and dissolution of this entire enterprize would soon have to be recorded. However necessary money may be, yet mountains of wealth, *alone*, could never keep this work alive. For our numerical force, as a people, perhaps we have the smallest money power of any community; but we believe we have on the working classes a very strong hold, and it is by the incessant working among this class of Society that accounts for past success. We have been complimented by some as a slender talented, though zealous people; but we are not certain that *all* the compliments of this kind fully applies, for we do not repudiate knowledge, but highly approve and encourage it; yet we fully agree with the teachings of the Bible, the great fountain of all certain literature and theology, that he who "winneth souls is wise."

State patronage has never had any influence in relation to this work, in sustaining its life, as we never had it, nor is it likely we shall. In elevating thousands of her Majesty's subjects from moral degradation to happiness and self-respect, not a farthing has ever been received by our treasurer in England, nor a cent in Canada; and thus the reliance must be on the voluntary support of our friends, as heretofore.

But suppose our funds were equal to our engagements, instead of being considerably behind, it would not follow that our prosperity would be as great in the future as in the past, unless two considerations are secured—1st. that we have a succession of right agents, influenced by purity of motive, not spurred to duty by the pressure

of committees, but earnest and self-denying—for the love of souls “instant in season and out of season; to reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with all long suffering and doctrine.” 2ndly. There must be forthcoming a larger measure of the baptism of the Holy Ghost, to imbue the ministry and members, and constitute what Hugh Bourne called the “converting gift.” The exercise of the converting gift will perpetuate our work—will defend it against schism, corruption of doctrine, vain philosophy, the traditions of men, and all the host of Colensos, &c., that may rise up in the world.

We need not here use argument to press this missionary work, for little that is original in idea can be urged in this day; nor is it necessary to show any array of figures for after repeating, as they are soon forgotten. We may observe, however, that our printed yearly report is in circulation among our friends, for their perusal. It will there be seen that the disbursements exceed the receipts by \$3,547 40.; that we have a grant from England of \$1946 00; which leaves a balance deficit of \$1,601 00. We trust the efforts now being made will reduce this deficiency. We have now thirty-four Mission Stations, and gracious revivals have been reported from several of them. Let there be, then, from the aspects of our country and personal responsibility, a deeper conviction of duty. Missionary labours are founded on the will of God—on the authority of the Bible; and we are bound by those obligations; and which obligations cannot be cancelled. With the contributions now given, fresh sacrifices will be demanded, and more heroic exertions required. Accept, dear friends, the gratitude of the Committee for past liberality, and be encouraged to attempt greater things, and you will be blessed in your deeds. Let us pray for and sympathise with the faithful missionary, exposed to trials, temptations, and sorrows. He is called by God, and sent out by the Committee to bear privations in the back and solitary Settlements, and appointed to go away from home and kindred; but your noble help and sympathy will revive and cheer him, and he will be able to say—

“Should fate command me to the farthest verge  
Of the green earth; to distant, barbarous climes;  
Rivers unknown to song; where first the sun  
Gilds Indian mountains; or his setting beam  
Flames on the Atlantic isles; 'tis nought to me,  
Since God is ever present, ever felt,  
In the void waste, as in the city full;  
And where He vital breathes, there must be joy.”
