This vocabulary is far from being complete, and it would be impossible under the present circumstances, to issue a complete Dictionary of the Shushwa language.

The object here is to give a vocabulary containing the most usual words, and even here some words are unavoidably left out.

The present little work is likely to absorb five or six numbers, of 16 pages each, after which, it will be

revised, and if possible
reissued from plates.

After the Shushwap
vocabulary has been com-
piled, it will be easy to
make the same for the
Thomson, Okanagan,
and other Indian Languages
belonging to the Salish
family.

A great deal depends
on the interest taken in
the work, and on the
encouragement received
from those interested.
