BILL.

An Act to repeal the Act providing for the distribution of the Printed Copies of the Provincial Statutes, and to make better provision for the distribution thereof.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Act Preamble. hereinafter mentioned, and to make better provision for the distribution of the Printed Statutes: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

5 That the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's 12 Vict. c. 16, Reign, and intituled "*An Act to amend the law relative to* repealed. *the printing and distribution of the Provincial Statutes,*" shall be and is hereby repealed; Provido. Provided always that no Act thereby repealed shall be revived by the repeal
10 of the said Act.

15 II. And be it enacted, That one complete copy of the Provincial Statutes shall be sent to each Municipality in this Province for the use of such Municipality, and one complete copy to each of the Judges of the Superior Courts and of the Circuit and County Courts; and to the several Public Departments and Offices of the Government and the Justices of the Peace, but not to any other officers. To whom copies shall be sent.

20 III. And be it enacted, That the Queen's Printer shall be bound to keep copies of the said Statutes on hand for sale at the contract price, but not exceeding 3,000 copies. Queen's Printer to keep copies at a certain price.
