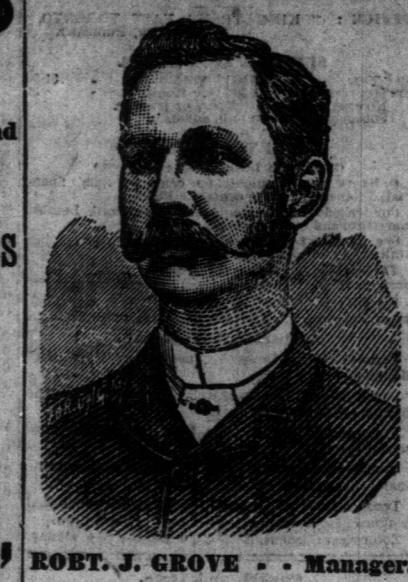

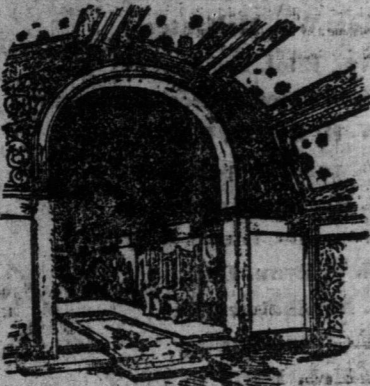

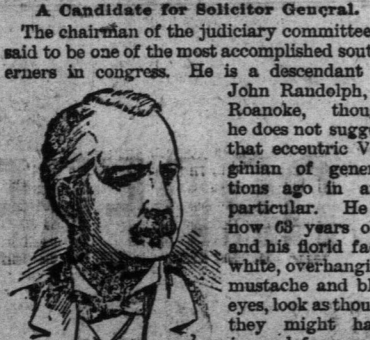
AN ELABORATE TEMPLE. Success in Buffalo Road Dedicated to Cremation.

The channel will be fitted up with an altar, a lectern and other accessories to the proper carrying out of a religious ceremony.

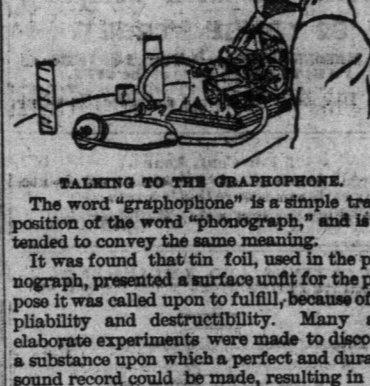

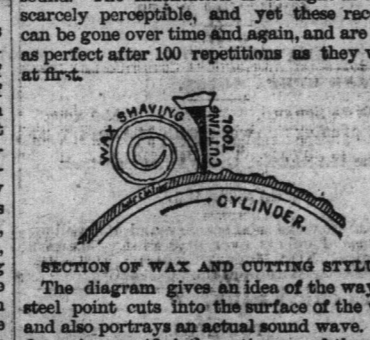
THE GRAPHOPHONE. EDISON'S PHONOGRAPH REVIVED UNDER A NEW NAME.



One of the most marvelous inventions in the world's history—a machine which records sound, leaving it to be repeated at will.



The word "graphophone" is a simple translation of the word "phonograph," and is intended to convey the same meaning.



On a diaphragm three inches in diameter a steel point is attached, which cuts a minute furrow in the surface of the waxed cylinder.

Should a correspondent also have a graphophone, the writer of a letter could in a few moments dictate what would be a lengthy epistle, enclose it in a box about the size of the apothecary's "pill box," place a stamp thereon and transmit through the mails.
