THE TRIPARTITE AGREEMENT

THE PARTIES TO IT ARRIVE AT A FINAL SETTLEMENT.

A New Union Station to be built at a cost of \$500,000. A source of difficulty between the Railway and the City removed and the Dora of Peace Circle Overhead.

There was a hastily summoned meeting of the City Council yesterday afternoon to confer with the great magnates of the Grand Trunk and Canadian Pacific Railways, with a view to securing a final settlement of the Eglantine difficulty.

The first of the new rails were laid yesterday afternoon on King-street, with before except for a misunderstanding with the city as to the location of the tracks.

From a railway standpoint the new Union Station will be well-situated. Every siding, both under and over, in the yards, connects with the main lines at both ends with two exceptions, those for fruit and milk, which of course require to be "through" sidings.

At the beginning of the discussion Ald. Leslie objected strongly to the reading of the agreement clause by clause. He said the city was willing to accept the agreement in its present form and no other. As far as he was concerned he would not be asked to sign a document which he had not read.

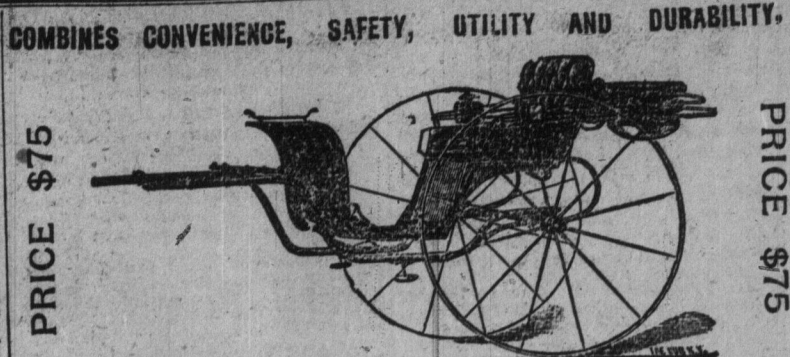
