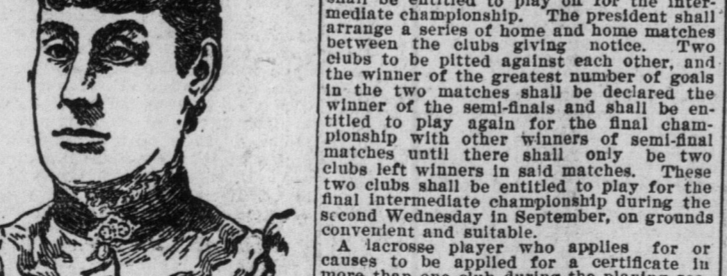

A Telegraph Operator Lays Claim to a Wonderful Feat.

New York, March 29.—C. D. Vaughn, manager of the Western Union Telegraph Company's station, at the foot of West Fifty-sixth street, has just completed an invention by the use of which it will be possible to telephone across the ocean.

The reason it is impossible to telephone more than a thousand miles by the Bell method, said Mr. Vaughn yesterday, "is because the induction coil and transmitter now in use will not stand a greater electric power than is contained in the coils. After years of experiment I have succeeded in perfecting an improved condenser of induction coil and transmitter that will permit the use of forty or fifty volts and about thirty-five to forty cells."
