## Forest Fires！

The Attention of the Public is called ito the following provisions of the FOREST FIRE ACT：

1－Any person who sets out，makes starts a Day of April and the First Day of December，in or near woods，or without selecting a place free from dry trees， underbrush or other inflammable material in which to
make or start such FIRE，or fails to remove all such dry wood，brushwood or inflammable material within a distance of ten feet from such fire in every direction， or fails to completely extinguish the same before lear－
2．－Throws or Drops any Burning Match，Ashes of
a Pipe，Lighted Cigar or any other burning substance． a Pipe，Lighted Cigar or any other burning substance．
3．－Or fails to totally extinguish any camp fire be－ fore breaking camp，shall be liable to a Penalty of not
less than $\$ 50$ nor more than $\$ 400$ ，or imprisonment for a period of twelve months．
