## BILL.

An Act to incorporate "Les Clercs Paroissiaux ou
"Catéchistes de Saint Viateur," in the Village of Industry, in the County of Berthier.

WHEREAS an Association hath existed for Preamble. several years in the Village of Industry, in the County of Berthier, under the name of "Les Clercs Paroissiaux ou Catéchistes de 5 "Saint Viateur," for the instruction of young persons in the sciences. and in the elements thereof; and whereas the Members of the said Association nave, by their petition, prayed to be incorporated, and, in consideration of the 10 great benefits which must arise from the Institution, it is expedient to grant their prayer:

Be it therefore enacted, \&cc. : and it is here- The present by enacted by the authority of the same, that Mombers, and the Rev. François Thérèse Lahaye, Priest, shall hercafter Etienne Champagneur, Augustin Fayard, Louis Chrétien, Abraham Jacques Duhaut, Paschal Lajoie, Louis Langlais, Joseph Vadeboncœur, Octave Gaudreault, Godfroy Lacas, and Gilbert Joly, the present officers and mem20 bers of the said Association, and such other persons as shall hereafter become members of the said Associction according to the Rules and Regulations thereof and the provisions of this Act shall be, and they are hereby consti25 tuted and declared to be a body politic and corporate, in deed and in name, by the name of "Les Clercs Paroissiaux ou Catéchistes de. Corporate "Saint Viateur," and by that name shall have name and perpetual succession and a common seal, and 30 shall have power, from time to time, to alter, renew, or change such common seal at their pleasure, and shall, by the same name, from time to time, and at all times hereafter, be able and capable to purchase, acquire, hold, possess

and enjoy, and to have, take, and receive, to them and their successors, to and for the uses and purposes of the said corporation, any lands, tenements, and hereditaments, and real or immoveable property and estate, situated, lying, and being within this province, not exceeding in yearly value the sum of
currency, and the same to sell, alienate, and dispose of, and to purchase others in their stead, for the same purpose; and by the said 10 name shall and may be able and capable in law to suc, and ko a yed, inplead and ve in pleaded, answer and be answered unto, in all courts of law and places whatsoever, in as large, ample, and beneficial a manner as any other 15 body politic or corporate, or as any persons able or capable in law may or can sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in any matter whatsoever; and any majority of the members of the cor-20 poration for the time being, shall have power
