**SALADS AND SANDWICHES.**  
Hindoo Salad—Arrange four slices of tomato on a bed of shredded lettuce. Pile some shavings celery on two of the slices and on the other two some finely cut water-cress garnish with small pieces of tomato and serve with French dressing.

**Tomato and Cucumber Salad**—Arrange a slice of tomato and cucumber until six slices have been piled one on top of another, arrange on lettuce leaves and garnish with strips of red and green peppers. Remove seeds from peppers and parboil in boiling water for five minutes.

**Green Mayonnaise**—Mix one teaspoon each of mustard, salt and powdered sugar, add a few grains of cayenne, the yolks of two eggs and one-half teaspoon of vinegar. Add very gradually one-half cup of olive oil and mix with vigor and lemon juice, adding in this amount add one-quarter cup of green pepper and one-half cup of green peas.

**Oil-Soaked Sandwiches**—Soak one-half cup of bread in one-half cup of boiling water, and when lukewarm, divide into three equal parts. Dissolve in three tablespoons of lukewarm water one-half tablespoon each of lard, butter, salt and pepper. Add one-half cup of white flour and enough water to make a stiff dough. Roll out and bake in a shallow pan.
