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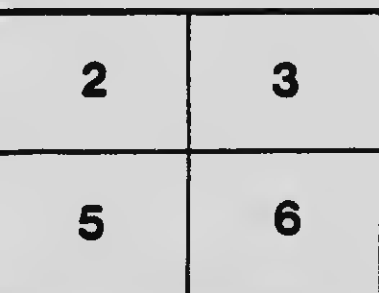
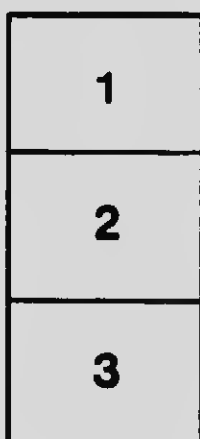
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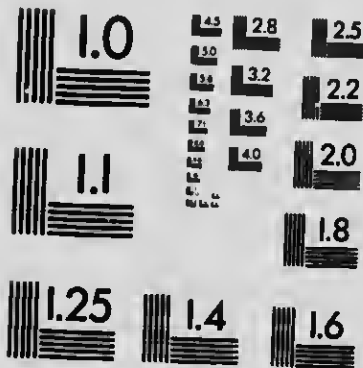

The objects for which this Association exists may be stated broadly as:

(1) Improvement in the conditions under which Postal Clerks of the different city post offices in Canada are called upon to perform their duties; and also the salaries to be paid them for same.

(2) The consideration of such means as may be devised by them for the performance of these duties as efficiently and economically as possible, consistently with prompt and satisfactory service to the general public whose servants they are.

By foregathering in convention from time to time, and exchanging views and comparing notes, it has been found that conditions vary in different post offices, not being exactly similar in any two offices in Canada. It has also been observed that methods of doing work in some offices are superior to those prevailing elsewhere; and by such comparison of methods the best means of increasing the efficiency of the whole service may be found.

In the matter of salary increases, as well as in other improved conditions, especially with regard to semi-staff offices, the Postal Clerks of Canada have just reason to be proud of the results obtained from the way in which their grievances have been recognized by the Post Office Dept. and the Government, after due and reasonable representations made by the proper officials of this Association as instructed by the several conventions in session.

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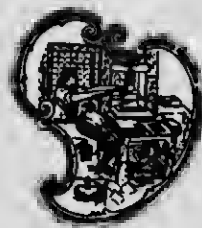
