The startling revelations which appeared in the World of yesterday regarding the sale of meat with disease in Toronto, created a good deal of uneasiness and was the topic of conversation all over the city.

The telephone at the Health Department was rung from morning until evening, and the quizzers asking if it were safe to eat any kind of meat. Officials of the Provincial Board of Health who received their first intimation of the case, were early on hand for further particulars, but little more was to be had, until the commission was sought later.
