Hamilton Aldermen Brought His Worship to Book for Doing Things All by Himself.

Hamilton, Sept. 14.—(Special.)—Mayor Tuckett was at the Finance Committee this afternoon called down by Ald. Colquhoun for changing the hour of the meeting from 5 to 4 o'clock, for ordering the Treasurer to call for tenders from the banks for doing the exchange, and Ald. Brown called him down for calling a meeting of the Board of Works without consulting him, his chairman.

The spur line matter was discussed, and a resolution was passed stating that in the event of an order being made by the Railway Committee of the Privy Council for extending the Hamilton and Milton Road to the high level over Burlington Heights, the necessary improvements to the road should be made by the road or railway company, and to be the property of the city, the road company having right of way only to carry a motor car and trailer, not less than 24 feet wide of sufficient capacity to carry a motor car and trailer satisfactory to the government engineer, and to be the property of the city; that the road company shall have no further rights to collect tolls, and to consent to any order contracting the foregoing.

Nagara Camp. The 12th, 21st and 35th Battalions passed through Toronto yesterday en route to Niagara camp. Mr. A. F. Webster, whose services as a volunteer were accepted for the transportation of the troops via the Niagara Navigation Co., made all the necessary arrangements.

Some Solid Ore. A claim considered one of the most promising prospects in the district, which is operated by a stock company, a shaft has been sunk 90 feet, and in which one which improves with depth. The Hattie Brown, which was lately stocked, has a fine showing of gold-copper vein. The few is being developed.
