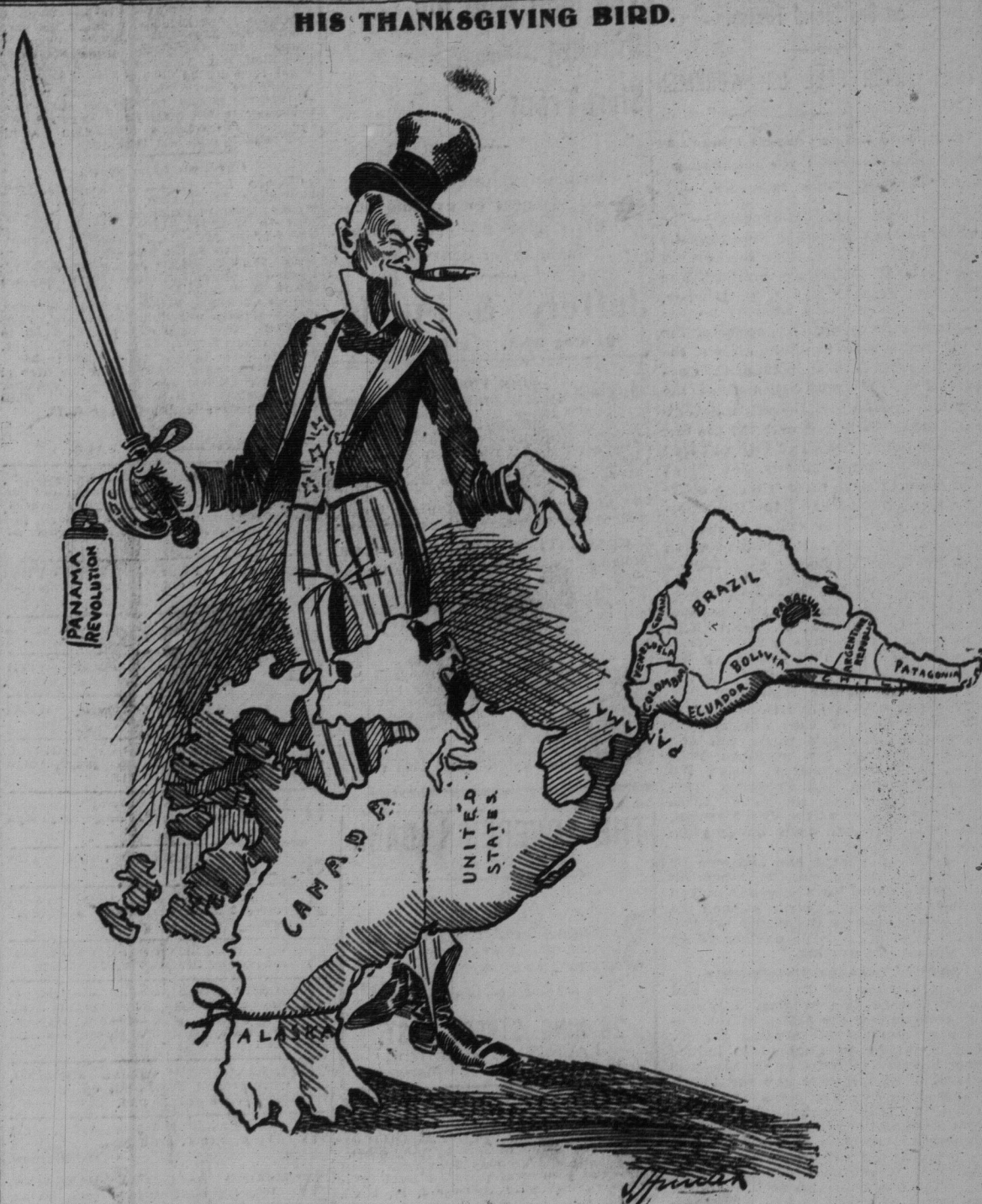

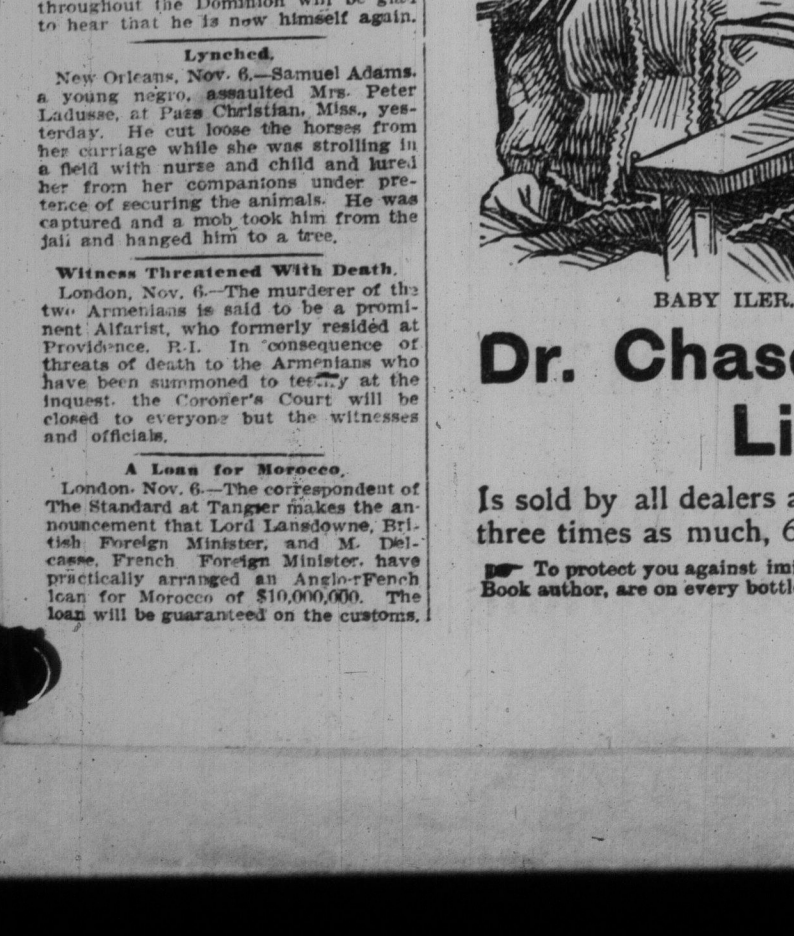

The Referendum Committee met on Tuesday, and decided to ask the Council to submit a local option by-law.

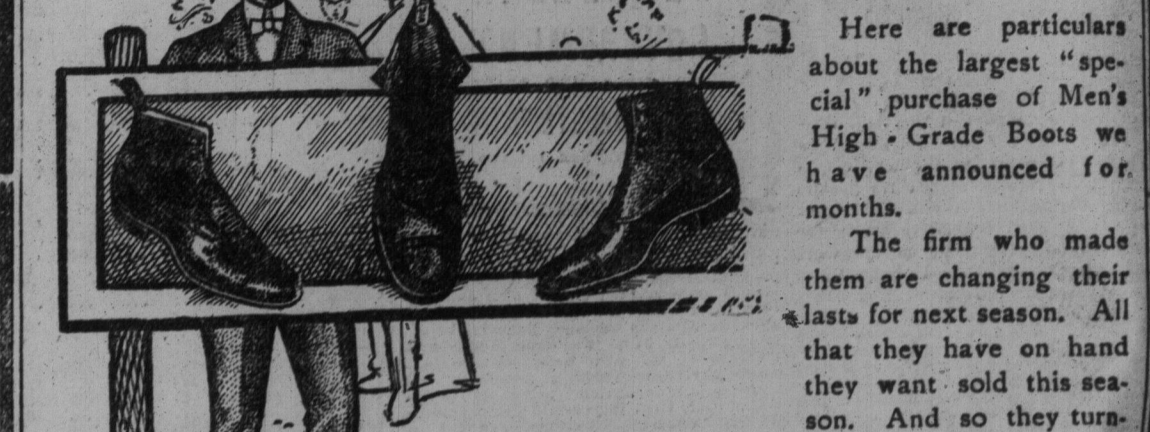
