The Stock Farm.

The Local Government met in St. John last week, and among other business transacted was the decision on the Stock Farm. In their wisdom and discretion they set aside the recommendation of the Board of Agriculture, that either the "Gray" farm above Fredericton, or "the Deer" farm at Sumner should be chosen, and determined upon the leasing of the "City farm," at Hampton. They were, we suppose, guided in their choice both by the superiority of the said farm, for the purpose, and the centrality of its position which makes it more easily accessible to the majority of the farmers of the Province than either, or at least than one of the farms recommended, or any of those offered to the government.

We would have liked to have seen the Stock Farm located in our neighbourhood—of course at Mr. Gray's fine place as well as anywhere—but it is perhaps just as well that the government took upon themselves the fixing of its location; it will at any rate stop the mouths of those who have been giving out that the question of where the Stock Farm would be located, had all along been determined upon, and that it certainly would be near the capital.

The "City farm" is described as being one of the best farms in King's County. It forms a portion of the well-known Palmer property and fronts on the Hammond River. It comprises 75 acres of upland under cultivation, 75 acres of intervals, which are overflooded both by spring and fall freshets. About 100 acres of excellent pasturage with a large quantity of woodland. The buildings, barns, stables, sheep pens, and other buildings are all in good order, and the farm is well fenced, and in good condition generally. The barnyard is well supplied with water brought in through pipes from a spring in the highland. The farm cuts a large quantity of hay, the highest is growing, and the pasturage is capable of extension when needed, the soil is remarkably free from stones, and is capable of supporting a large amount of stock. If the "City Farm" comes up to the description, the government have made an excellent choice.

We sincerely hope that the experiment of a Stock Farm will turn out successful, and have no doubt that it will if it is properly managed. One or two of the papers of the "Telegraph" have been speaking of it as if they had been speaking of all the farmers of the Province, but we are confident, that their opposition to the farm, presumably in the interest of the farmer, and of the Province, is based on a false assumption, and that, on the contrary, the project has the support and good wishes of a majority of the said farmers.

The Stock Farm we look upon as an experiment, a tentative step towards the more direct encouragement to agriculture, that has hitherto received. That interest is growing, and is year by year becoming more important, and something must be done before long to give young men who determine to follow farming as their life's occupation, systematic instruction. The government farm now leased, might be made to include a model and experimental farm, after that of Guelph, of which we speak, in another column. So the Stock Farm may be looked upon as a step in that direction, and those who oppose it, and yet urge the establishment of a Model Farm, should look upon it as only a part of a project which will add to the value of the farm, in time, make a whole, and mitigate their aversion to it. How often must it be said, that "Rome was not built in a day."

Sawdust and Paper Pulp.

Sawdust is a trouble to mill-owners, a nuisance to people living in the neighbourhood of mills, and an annoyance to Fishery Inspectors and Wardens. How best to get rid of the sawdust, has long been a problem. In the vicinity of some mills fires have been kept burning, but they are not deemed lighted in signal of a difficulty overcome, a victory achieved, for the fires are only less of a nuisance than the nuisance they are meant to get rid of. An embankment is sometimes built from sawdust, (as that below the first mill in our vicinity,) but all mill-owners will not go to the labor and expense that such a work imposed. Sawdust will be dumped into the river in the teeth of the law, to the injury of the fish. It is time when sawdust will be turned to a nuisance, but a source of profit? The age, the most unlikely things are no longer to use and profit, even the weeds of the gardens and fields. Why not sawdust? Sawdust can be compressed and converted into lumber serviceable for some purposes. But that would not be a handy way of getting rid of the sawdust of our mills. Wood can be ground and converted into pulp; that much more easily can its dust. Paper has been made and is made from immense variety of articles, wood among the rest. Since that is so, the problem, what to do with sawdust would be solved, but for one difficulty. In the sawdust from the mills there are knots and particles of resinous wood are mingled. To make paper pulp, the sawdust must be clean and pure, be free of the above substances. When the difficulty is solved, (and who doubts that it will be when invention is persistently directed to it,) paper pulp factories may be erected in the vicinity of mills, and sawdust utilized on the spot. We see that this prospect has aroused the interest of the St. Croix Courier, and who is calling on the capitalists of St. Stephen to take the matter into consideration. Observed by the success which followed his persistent agitation for the erection of a Cotton Mill, it may be expected that he will not desert from working up paper pulp from sawdust until a factory is established. May success attend his agitation.

The Cornish Dinner.

Last Thursday, forty gentlemen of St. John superlative men in every respect, spent the evening at U. S. Consul, Gen. Warner, and welcomed the incoming one, Hon. Mr. Feenden, by a dinner in the City Club. The graceful compliment was carried out in the handsome and hearty manner customary in St. John on similar social and public occasions. The speech of Gen. Warner, was feeling and appropriate, that of Mr. Feenden in answer to the toast, "the President of the United States," when speaking of the sympathy shown for the stricken President in Great Britain and Canada, by the Queen and all classes of her subjects, was worthy of the occasion. But why did Mr. Feenden introduce in the latter end of his speech "Mr. Jones the pork stealer." Why indeed, unless he so strongly wished by a coarse parody to typify and condemn the office seeking grabbing spirit prevalent in the States, which has helped to work the woe under which the nation is now suffering, that he was careless whether a construction might be put upon it unfavorable to himself.

Ontario's Model Farm.

The Toronto Globe, of late date, has an interesting account of a visit paid by Mr. Andrew Glass, head of the seed division of the U. S. Agricultural Department, to the model farm at Guelph. Mr. Glass was not successful in his more immediate object, to endeavor to obtain some new variety of wheat to take the place of the "Clawson" or "Seneca," now so popular on both sides of the line, but which begins to show signs of deteriorating. The Guelph farm grain room contains hundreds of samples of different varieties of all cereals, but no specimens of wheat which would likely be good substitutes for the kinds now deteriorating in the States. But he had a good opportunity under the guidance of Principal Mills and Professor Brown of inspecting the model farm, which has now more than a provincial reputation.

While the farmers in this Province have been suffering from excessive falls of rain, in the neighbourhood of Guelph there has been excessive drought, and all the grain crops, save Indian corn, have been gathered, so that the fields of the farm presented a bare and burnt brown appearance, which though not attractive to the eye, suggested garnered abundance. The turnips and mangel-worms were not so good as usual; but there was a large field of the former, so well developed and uniformly good as to draw from Mr. Glass the remark that it was not only the finest field of turnip he had seen in Canada, but the most magnificent he had seen anywhere in the continent. The bag of turnips kept in check from ravaging the potatoes, and they promise well, clover was heavy, and peas very promising.

The cattle attracted the special notice of the American Commissioner, these included both imported and Canadian breeds, which were fit to compare with the best animals of their respective classes on the continent. In one field there were "forty cattle grazing as one," (as Wordsworth says,) comprising Holsteins, Ayrshires, Short-horns, and Ayrshires of a beautiful light brown, shaded with white, which is now the fashionable color. Mr. Glass also had an opportunity to inspect a number of animals imported from Great Britain, which arrived on the model farm, after three months quarantine on Grose Island, the morning of his visit.

"The animals were selected by Mr. Hunter from some of the best herds in Britain, and an average price paid for each of seventy guineas. On attempting to catch some that were nearing a dam which is about thirty rods above the site of the bridge, they were carried by the rapid current towards the shore below, where they fell, and were seen to be struggling. There was some moment for thought, and the three men leaped into the rushing water, hoping by some means to reach the shore in safety. Reid, with all most superhuman effort succeeded, but his two companions were so exhausted when they reached the shore, that they were unable from the circumstances to render help.
