An Act to amend "The Fishery Act."

WHEREAS with a view to secure the more efficient working of Preamble. the Act passed in the twenty-second year of Her Majesty's 22 V. c. 86. reign, intituled "The Fishery Act," it is expedient to make certain amendments thereto; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

5 I. The fourth section of the said Act shall be amended by substituting Sect. 4 the word "fifteen" for the word "nine" after the words "for any amended. term not exceeding," in the third line thereof.

II. The fifth section of the said Act shall be amended by the omission Sect. 5 of the word "Four" in the seventh line of the said section before the amended to Cease out the turn 10 words "Overseers may be appointed."

Ill. The eleventh section of the said Act shall be amended by omitting Sect. 11 the words "or within three miles of the coast of the mainland, or of amended. islands" in the third and fourth lines of the said section, after the words "or the remains of offal or fish in any such river."

15 IV. The twenty-second section of the said Act shall be amended by Sect. 12 substituting the word "five" for the word "two," after the words "in amended. the arms and," in the fourth line of the said section.

V. The twenty-fifth section of the said Act shall be amended by Sect. 25 adding the words " or near " after the words " in any way whatever amended. 20 at" in the second line of the said section.

VI. The following shall be substituted for the thirty-first section of New sect. inthe said Act: "It shall not be lawful to fish for, catch, or kill any stead of 35.
