Florence, Sept. 25th.—When it became known here that Garthaldi had been arrested his partisans in this city were greatly exasperated, and appearing in the streets in crowds made a tarbulent demonstration of sympathy for their leader. The manifestations finally developed into a riot, but the disturbances, though threatening, was appressed by the Government. All the volunteers of Garibaldi, who had gathered at various points on the Roman frontier, have been compelled to daperes and retire by the Italian troops. King Victor Emmanuel has issued another proclamation, in which he says that the faith of the Government, pledged in its treaties with foreign powers, exacted of it the pairful duty of arresting Garibaldi, the eaknowledged leader of the movement, in direct violation of these treaties. It maid the Italian Government has offered to send Garibaldi to his home at Caprers, and relieve bim of all constrant; if he will give his parole not to engage in further hostilities against the Roman States.


