"The New Dominion."
The St. John (N. B.) TRIBUNE is
very indignant because the pious
"Dominion of Canada" is merely called
the "New Dominion" by the United
States papers. A rose by any other
name may smell as sweet, but would
not the Republic of the Republic be a
little better?—New York Herald.
The Herald does not fairly state our
complaint. It was not that "New Dom-
inion" is substituted for "Dominion of
Canada," but that the word "Dominion"
is used unnecessarily. There is no
more cause for saying "Dominion of
Canada in common parlance than for
saying "Republic of the United States,"
"Empire of Russia," "Kingdom of
Spain." The Herald will now be under-
stood that our objection to "Republic of
Canada," as a news heading, would be
just as strong as our objection to
"The New Dominion," a name manu-
factured in a New York editor's man-
ufacture as a sounding substitute for "Ca-
nada."

The Coal Trade.
A dispatch from New York asserting that
a corner in coal has been formed by which
a decided increase of price is to be exacted
next winter, gives an erroneous impres-
sion. The matter appears to have been dis-
puted by leading operators, who at pre-
sent prices they are hardly able to pay run-
ning expenses, but there is a diversity of
opinion among them which may prevent a
combination. According to the New York
Post, a director of the Delaware and Hud-
son Canal Company says no definite ar-
rangements have been made, but he con-
siders such a result probable, as the large
companies generally desire it, as they are
not making anything. One or two other
parties connected with large coal prop-
erty in the Philadelphia and Reading
Railroad Company have lately offered to
sell all the coal mined in the Schuylkill
region at a commission of ten cents per
ton, instead of twenty-five cents, as heretofore
charged. Further, it is said, the
company contemplates entering the retail
trade. An official of the Pennsylvania Coal
Company says no proposition for the com-
bination has been made to them. He
thought a large increase in the price of
coal would be greatly impeded, as new
collieries would be opened and a
spirited competition followed. There is
doubtless a movement in some of the large
companies to secure an increase for the
year 1873, but the highest price hitherto
paid by them is said to be \$5 per ton.
The "middle-men" are averse to the movement
and the opposition likely to be developed
by the public given to the scheme may
defeat it.

A Senate Committee is investigating the
Kansas bribery case. Mr. Sidney Clarke,
formerly a member of Congress from Kan-
sas and a competitor of Caldwell in the
Senatorial contest, gave a straightforward
narrative of the alleged bribery by which
Caldwell is said to have gained the elec-
tion. There are the specifications, even to
Caldwell's reported programme for getting
reimbursement of his election expenses by
legislation in Congress.

An Indoor Tragedy.
Well nigh half a century ago a newly-
married couple settled in one of the wa-
rrens of Pennsylvania. They had
countenances that were as bright as
what their neighbors deemed a fair capital
with which to begin life—a well-stocked
though small farm, sound health, good
common sense, and a more than average
amount of shrewd intelligence and culture.
Under all this most sincere trust in God
and a jealous, sensitive love for each other,
neither of which their neighbors knew
much about. American backwoods farm-
ers take a pride in covering their counten-
ances with a hide so tough as that of their own
beaver. They had three or four children,
and night after night, over the kitchen
fire, the problem they set themselves to
answer was, what is the best thing we can
do with them, and for them? The question
