What and How to Plant in the Fall. One of the puzzling questions which many farmers are contemplating setting out fruit trees, is what they shall plant in the fall.

It is quite a safe rule to follow, over a large part of the country, both east and west of the Alleghenies, to plant in the fall, and the stone fruits, the peach, plum and cherry in the spring.

Standard fruit trees are about right at twenty feet apart and dwarf at twelve to fifteen feet apart.

There are several good ways to lay out a fruit plantation, but the cheapest and easiest is the one in which horse power is used to

as near as possible the same depth as it stood in the nursery and with the largest branches towards the walling, or inner, side, which comes from the so called over-wind of the country.
