CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS. ONTARIO.
The strength which is shown by the lumber market is very encouraging to holders of stock. Information from manufacturers and dealers in pine is decidedly optimistic, and the outlook for building operations is improving as the sceson advences. Therc is a heavy local demand, and a liberal distribution to the Eastern States. The new cut apparently is having no influcnce upon prices; consequently investors who have delayed carrying out proposed undertakings are now procceding with the work, The stateinent of the manager of the Bauk of Diontreal that the lumber markets were congested and prices ruling low has clicited much unfavorable comment. So far as the markets of Ca nada and the United States are concerled, his statements are widely at variance with the facts, as it is many years since the mardet lins lecen in a more healthy cundition. Witt. mmil culls, for instance, salling at \$1 aq

QUEBEC ANH NEll brunswick.
Shipping of lumber iaring tice past week from the eastern povinses has been quite active. Ileavy :hepments liave been made to Great 13. ikin, and vessels liave loaded for South Aumerica und Antiverp. The shmpuent to Antwerp is the first that has :aher place for several years. The mumber of vessels under charter seems 10 indicate that the export of spruce l::mber this season will be heavier ilian was anticipated earlier in the vear. The market for square and waney timber is showing strength, pine imber having advanced from one to three cents per cubic foot. Most of the log drives in Quebec are likely to rcach the mills, but in New Brunswick several drives have already been hung
united starts.
The past wetk has been one of mausual activity in lumocr caicles The buying has been on a comparatively large scalc, and sales made in the Lake Superior district l, 2ve lecen at the top prices of the year. Although some of the new cut is :inhost in shipping condition, the sawing scason having been in progress for six weeks, white pinc lumber is calibibiting increased strength. ilacre scems to be a large present and prospective demand, and a strong liclici :i-at there will be no material decline in prices during the summer. jrom Duluth the sale is reported of several million lect of No. 3 and better at $\$ 18$, which is a remarkable price. The cast is buying quite liberally, and shliough receipts of lumber at buffalo and Tonawanda have been quite licavy, the grades arc still somewhat broken. In view of the attitude oi lle vestern producers the dealers at castern distributing points may be freced to advance prices. Such a possibility at this scason of the year is unusual. The manufacturers of spruce are show ing great confidence in the faturc of
prices, the present asking price at Boston being fifty cents above tho list. The improvement in inardwoods is slow. Sales of bnsswood are on the increase, but chan and raple are quict. j3rown and llack ash are meeting with better enquiry.
gemat britain.

About the only encouraging news from Great britain is the announcement that at resent sales the buying has shown more animation. Other conditions remain unchanged. The import of timber so far this scason has been little less than for the corresponding period of last ycar, and it is feared that even lower prices may be witnessed before the season closes. A large quantity of the North of Europe production is still unsold. White sca shippers have lately closed some contracts, but the quotations are believed to be fifty shillings lower than the price quoted at the opening of the season. The building trade is inactive, even in the face of the compatativeiy low price of lumber. While pine deals are reasonably firm, the market for spruce is quite heavy. It is reported that Crnadian shippers are accepting lower prices. For instance, $3 \times 9$ third spruce has sold at $\epsilon_{3} 3$ 2s 6 a ci.f. London, and $3 \times 7-8 t i s$ at 675 s , the latter being a reduction of ios per standard on battens. There is a fair demand for 1 -inch spruce, but the quantity of this width available is not large.

## Mandroba and bitish colomma.

There has been a decided improvement in the lumber demand in Winnipeg, and a slightly better trade Hiroughout the piovince. Building operatious are quite active, and higher prices for lumber are looked for in the near future. Conditions in British Columlia are reasonably satisfactory, although foreign shipments have not been heavy. The Provincial Govcrnment has prohibited the export of cedar logs, which has affected a numher of loggers. A considerable quantity of such logs has been exported to the coast sections of Washington State, where the cedar limits are of little account.

The Whaley Lumber Company, whose mill at Funtsville, Ont., was bursed recently, rre reported to bave sold their stock of logs to a Hamilou firm.

The steamer Bionlegan has sailed from Ship Island for Biontrenl, with 775,000 fect of pitch pinc, consigned to Shearer \& Brown.
The steamer Iovstaken is loading cargo of deals at Riviere du loup, Que., for the U.K., and the steame Varax is abont to load at Montreal.
The steamer Magea is loading 2 , 000,000 fect of lumber at Montreal for Antwerp, the shippers being Watson \& Todd. This is the first shipment of lumber made from Montreal to Antwerp for many years past.
Eastern spruce is held in New York at $\$ 18$ to $\$ 20$. In Portland, Maine, prices are $\$ 21$ for $12-\mathrm{luch}, \$ 15.50$ for $1 \times 3$ to $1 \times 11$, and $\$ 16$ for scantling Spruce clapboards are quoted at $\$ 32$ for cetras, $\$ 30$ for clears, and $\$ 26$ for second clears. Dry spruce coverim! boards bring $\$ 15.50$ to $\$ 16$.
The steamer Georgia sailed last weck from Digby, N.S., for Cienfuegos, with lumber. The barque Lillian is loading lumber at Tusket Bridge, N.S., for Buenos Ayres. The brig. James Daly, is loading at Liverpuol, N.S., for the Barbadocs, and tl.e sch. Frances A. Rice will luad again at Weymouth, N.S., for the Wcst Indics.
The steamers Daventry and Gladstrey are loading lumber cargoes at Sillary Cove, Que, for the United Kingdom. The steamer Dunmoore Head is loading a cargo of deals at Thatiscan, Que., for Cork, Ireland. The Loughrigg Holme is abont to load a cargo of lumber at Montreal for Barrow, Eng., the shippers being C. H. Mremicha
C. H. Bichichacl, of Beaverstone Ont., states that they expect to have their drive of logs out in abont two wecks. On one of the creeks the water is low, and about 25,000
are in danger of being hung up.
A shipment of square timber, commrising four cribs of 135 picces, was made from I,indsay last weck for townslip, and consist. I chiefly of elm and birch.
The shingle market at Saginaw, Mich., is active, stocks being taken about as fast as they come from the saw. There is as yet very little saw. Teck accumulating, and as the product is not so large in castern Michi-
gan as years ngo, it is not expected that there will be any shingles piled up for any length of time. The marset is firm, with quotations there at 52.50 and $\$ 3.50$ for 18 -inch white pinc; $\$ 1.75$ to $\$ 3$ for 16 -inch white pine: celar shingles, $\$_{2}$ and $\$ 3$, for 18 -inch and $\$_{1} 50$ for 16 -inch cedar.
A correspondent thus refers to the Michigan lumber market: The market never manifested heulthier conditions. There is a demand for all kinds of stock. Good lumber is particularly firm. Michiran white pine is worth from $\$ 17$ to $\$_{25}$, and Canada stock from \$16 to \$21 for log run. Box lumber has not been so strong as ome other grades, but is quoted at $\$ 12.50$ to $\$ 15$. Norway is in demand, but muly two or three firms are cutling it, and the old stock is practic ally exhausted. It is worth $\$_{11}$ and up, according to dimension. Nill culls are worth \$12 to \$i3.
