KHARTOUM.

Khartoum is a town of Senaar, Africa, the centre of government of Egyptian Sudan, situated on the banks of the Bahr el-Azrek or Blue Nile, nearly at its junction with the White Nile; lat. 15° 36' N. lon. 32° 58' E.; pop. about 20,000. It is about 1,400 ft. above the sea, but the inundations of the White Nile frequently reach the earthen wall by which it is surrounded. The houses are mostly constructed of mud-brick buildings, a spacious quay on the banks of the Blue Nile, and some still more imposing erections on the other side of the river. There are extensive gardens and rows of date palms planted nearly half a century ago. The defensive drainage of the portion of the town built below high-water level renders it very unhealthy. The inhabitants are a mixture of Egyptians, Berbers, Arabs, Turks, Jews, Europeans, and negroes. They have a Coptic church, and a Catholic mission. Khartoum carries on an extensive ivory trade, mostly in the hands of six of the larger merchants, which facilitates also the operation of the regular slave traders, who pour into the negro country annually by thousands, on the roads over Kordofan and Darfour. The merchants of Khartoum maintain a great number of settlements in districts as far as possible to the present ivory countries, and among peaceful races devoted to agriculture. They have appointed the surrounding territory among themselves, and have brought the natives to a condition of vassalage. They are represented by agents who command the armed men of the country, determine what products the natives shall pay tribute, appoint and displace the local magistrates, carry on the trade in human flesh and life and fortune; to make an army of perhaps the worst material ever seen; to grow a flourishing trade and a fair revenue on the wildest anarchy in the world. The immensity of the undertaking, the infinity of details involved in a single step toward the end; the countless odds to be faced; the many perils, the deadly climate, the horrible vermin, the pestilential air, the nightly and daily alternations of overpowering heat and bitter cold; to be endured and overcome; the environment of bestial savagery and ruthless fanaticism—all these combine to make the achievement unique in human history.

THE BATTLE NEAR BIRTI.

Death of Gen. Barle.

The correspondent of the London Standard gives the following further particulars of the engagement which Gen. Barle lost his life. The British force consisted of the Black Watch and South Stafford regiments, a squadron of Hussars, two guns of the Egyptian artillery, an Egyptian camel corps and a battalion of the field hospital corps. The troops at once set to work to form a zarcha. In the meantime the enemy fired several shots from high hills. Our picket advanced and drove back the Arabs who had descended the hill to make the attack. Night ensued and guards were posted. Everything passed quietly during the night. On Tuesday morning the troops formed and advanced to the enemy's position, marching in two parallel columns. Two companies of the South Stafford regiment and two guns occupied ground directly in front of the enemy to attract their attention. At 8 o'clock our guns opened the attack and some time a desultory fire was maintained. In the meantime the main body of our troops was advancing steadily over almost impracticable ground—pushing the enemy before them and seizing each successive ridge by a short, determined rush. The forward movement was continued until the advanced troops reached the right rear of the enemy which rested on the river. This completed the attack and the enemy were surrounded. The enemy's position was a very strong one. It was on rocky, broken ground, and was strengthened by loopholed walls from which they maintained a heavy, well-directed fire.

HOW THE ENEMY'S WORKS WERE CARRIED.

The following additional particulars are given of Gen. Barle's capture of the enemy's works near Birti on Tuesday. After the British force had succeeded in completely surrounding the enemy's position Tuesday morning, Gen. Barle commanded the Black Watch regiment to carry the enemy's works at the point of the bayonet. The regiment responded gallantly to this command, the pipe struck up and with inspiring cheers the men moved forward with a steadiness and valor which called forth expressions of admiration from Gen. Barle. From loop-holes in the enemy's works rifle-pieces were shot out continuously, but the Black Watch kept bravely advancing. They scaled the difficult rocks which lay in their path, and drove the rebels from their shelter at the point of the bayonet. Unhappily, Gen. Barle fell at this point as he was gallantly leading his troops to victory. Meantime, the cavalry pushed past the scene of conflict and captured the enemy's camp, three miles to the rear of their entrenched position. This maneuver was accomplished before the Black Watch had succeeded in carrying the main position. While the main attack was being delivered two companies of the South Staffordshire regiment were directed to seize a high rocky hill which the rebels were stoutly defending. The British sprang boldly to the charge, but the enemy clung desperately to their position and despite the ground inch by inch.

What is the force today? Why, the force could be sent in an infinitely shorter number of hours than days were consumed in getting across the four hundred miles of inaccessible ravine and river. It is true that at that time the place was inaccessible by the usual route, and that the expedition had been found so useful to him in encountering the attacks of the Nile—and I am right glad to know that, acting with his usual foresight and consideration, he availed himself, not only of that knowledge, but of the services of the Canadian voyageurs, who were engaged of such use in his former expedition. Wonderful Escape.
Two men were digging a well at North Collin, N. Y. It had reached the depth of twenty feet, and a large bucket was used to draw the earth and stones to the surface by means of a windlass worked by a yoke of oxen. Suddenly the oxen turned about and ran against the windlass. The windlass toppled over in the well, and the bucket went whirling back to the bottom. The driver of the oxen became entangled in the rope and was also jerked into the well. On top of all the rest both oxen floundered into the opening and disappeared together. The mishap was witnessed by some men working near and a crowd soon gathered. All expected that the workmen were crushed to death. The oxen were wedged together in the well, which had stopped their fall. The rope attached to the bucket hung down on a piece of timber, which stopped the downward career of the bucket four feet below the men digging at the bottom, and they had saved themselves by crouching on the ground, when they heard the bucket overhead. The windlass was stopped by the bucket, and Albert Sherman had alighted in the soft dirt in the bucket. After an hour's hard work with rope and tackle the oxen, the windlass, the bucket, and the injured men were taken out, the latter nearly dead from fright, but without a scratch.
