TEMPORARY REGULATIONS,

Made by a Committee of His Majesty's Executive Council, at Montreal, and approved of by His Excellency the Governor in Chief, respecting Alien American Subjects, who may be desirous to come into the District of Montreal, and remain for a limited time.

I. THAT all persons so coming into the District of Montreal, shall be obliged to come by the Fort of Saint Johns.

II. That all persons so coming, or bringing Lumber of any kind, or Provisions, or Pot Ashes, or other commodities, (legally admissible) and being desirous of passing the place of entry aforesaid, shall be obliged to obtain a Certificate from the Collector or Comptroller, to pass the same.

III. That the Collector or Comptroller aforesaid may, (unless special circumstances against suspected characters should reasonably prevent) grant a Certificate to such persons, for two days at most, to come to Montreal, and there present themselves to the Police Office, for the purpose of obtaining the order of His Majesty's Executive Council, upon such petition as they shall see fit to present, under His Excellency the Governor's Regulations of Tenth July inst. which Certificate shall be produced to the General, or other Officer, commanding the Cordon of Troops, previous to their being allowed to pass through.

IV. That any such persons having Provisions, or Pot Ashes, or Commodities, as aforesaid, may obtain leave in the said Permit, to bring the same beyond the Fort of Saint Johns. But in all cases, Lumber, Provisions, Ashes, or other articles legally admissible, may be sent on to their destination, notwithstanding they may belong to Aliens, or have been conducted into the province by Aliens, provided, that in so sending on such Articles to their destination, His Majesty's Subjects only be employed, or such others as shall have obtained a Special Permission, given at Montreal for that purpose.
