An Act further to amend and extend the Act to establish Mutual Insurance Companies in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the provisions of the Acts of the late Province of Upper Canada, passed in the sixth year of the reign of King William the Fourth, intituled, *An Act to authorize the establishment of Mutual Insurance Companies in the several Districts of this Province*, as also the Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled, *An Act further to amend the Act to establish Mutual Insurance Companies in Upper Canada*; so as to allow the establishment of Municipal Mutual Insurance Companies in Upper Canada: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

10 I. It shall be lawful at any time for ten freeholders in any Municipality in Upper Canada to call a meeting of the inhabitants of such Municipality for the purpose of considering whether it be expedient to establish in such Municipality a Mutual Fire Insurance Company; such meeting to be called in the manner provided in and by the several sections of the said last above named Acts, and which therein apply to
15 Towns and Villages.

II. All the provisions contained in the said Acts in the preamble to this Act mentioned, shall apply and extend to all such Companies formed under the provisions of the said mentioned Acts, or either of them.
