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

## BILL.

An Act to authorize a Survey to define and establish the Boundary between the fourth Concession of the Townships of Montague and North Elmsley in the County of Lanark.

An Act to authorize a Survey to define and establish the Boundary between the fourth Concessions of the Townships of Montague and North Elmsley, in the County of Lanark.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the Session held in the 10th Preamble.

and 11th years of Her Majosty's Poisson. and 11th years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act 10 and 11 Vio. " to define and establish the Boundary between the fourth Con-"cession of Montague and North Elmsley," a certain Boundary 5 line was defined and established between the fourth Concessions of the said Townships; and whereas the said Act was by an Act passed in the 12th year of Her Majesty's Reign intituled, " An 12 Vic., cap. " Act ro repeal the Act defining the Boundary line between the 102. "fourth Concessions of the Townships of Montague and North 10 "Elmsley" afterwards repealed; And whereas John McGill Chambers has by his Petition set forth that the Boundary line was ascertained by and under the first mentioned Act, that a Town plot was surveyed by the said Petitioner fronting upon the Township line or Boundary so ascertained as aforesaid, and lots 15 laid out, sold and conveyed on the said Town plot by the said Petitioner, and further that he is liable to suits at the instance of the purchasers of the said lots, and that the witnesses to prove the correct and proper Boundary are old, and that he is therefore likely to lose the benefit of their evidence; And whereas the said 90 Petitioner hath for the reasons aforesaid petitioned that a new Survey should be made by a competent Surveyor at the proper cost of the said Petitioner, and that the line laid down and ascertained shall be permanently established as the Boundary line between the 4th Concessions of the said Townships; and whereas 95 it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner; Be it therefore enacted, &c.:

That within four months after the passing of this Act, it shall be commissioner the duty of the Commissioner of Crown Lands of the Province of of Crown Lands to cause Canada, to order and authorize a Survey of the said Boundary a new Survey 30 line between the 4th Concessions of the said Townships of Mon- to be made. tague and North Elmsley, to be made according to law, and to cause such Survey to be returned with all convenient speed after

such order and authority is given, to the Crown Lands office: Provided that the Surveyor or Surveyors appointed to make such Survey, shall not be required to commence the same, until paid or secured for the expenses thereof by the said John McGill Chambers.

II. And be it enacted, That the said Survey so returned shall connrmed or disallowed by be with all convenient speed either confirmed or dissallowed by the Commissioner of Crown Lands; that if it be confirmed a copy of the said Survey with all the plans and field notes shall be thereupon transmitted to the Register of the County of Lanark for re- 10 gistration, and that from and after the time of such registration the line laid down by such Survey shall be the permanent and unalterable Boundary between the 4th Concessions of said Townships.

New Survey of it be disallowed.

III. And be it enacted, That if the said Survey should be 15 disallowed as aforesaid, the Commissioner of Crown Lands shall immediately cause a re-survey in the manner hereinbefore provided for the first Survey under this Act.

Public Act. IV. And be it enacted. That this Act shall be a Public Act.
