CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS.

An interesting paper on bookkeeping as adapted for general bookkeepers. A general meeting of the Institute of Chartered Accountants was held in the Board of Trade Rooms last night. There were about thirty accountants present, and about half a dozen merchants.

The paper pointed out that many storekeepers, who pretended to keep books, kept them in no complicated manner that it was almost impossible to audit. It was pointed out that the returns from the wholesale commission merchant at least equalled what was paid out in trade from the store for produce, as very often merchants pay for produce more than they receive.

Mr. W. B. Hamilton said he was fully alive to the importance of book-keeping. He had known cases where failures occurred through a lack of book-keeping, and he would through a complicated system might be simplified, as a large number of accountants know nothing at all about accounts.
