THE GUINEA PIG A REEFECTOR.

The Orange and Black Spotted Brazilian Rodent Supplies Koch's Lymph.

BERLIN, Nov. 30.—Dr. Horwitz, chief editor of the National Zeitung, which is the only newspaper in Professor Koch's confidence, said to-day that the scarcity of guinea pigs for the purpose of making Koch's lymph is being overcome.

Over 500 of the animals are now being used to obtain a further supply of the lymph.

The lymph is prepared in an incubating stove within an air-tight space. This is hermetically sealed and sterilized by means of a red-heat oven.

The interior of the air-tight space is divided by an unglazed porcelain diaphragm into an upper and lower section. In the upper section is placed a salted meat broth in a gelatinous state containing colonies of the tubercle germ.

This is gradually liquefied and the gelatinous liquid drops down into the lower section, where it is mixed with the lymph.

By the injection of this mixture the tubercle germ is killed and at the same time the injection is sufficient to destroy the tubercle germ in the lymph.

DEATH DUE TO A LIAISON.

The Paris Murder Was Not an Act of Political Vengeance.

PARIS, Nov. 30.—The niece of General Selivkoff, who was found with a bullet wound in her head, is reported to have died yesterday, having arrived here for the purpose of arranging the details of her uncle's funeral.

The lady was a lover of a girl who had been enticed by a woman at the instance of General Selivkoff to leave her husband and this is claimed as the motive for the crime.

A liaison existed between the man and woman, and the latter, who was General Selivkoff's niece, was reported to have been in the Russian gendarmerie and head of the third section of the Department of Police.

At the time of the murder the lady was in the city in 1879 he had the police mission to this city given him.

Dr. Broca, in a report on the death of General Selivkoff, says that death resulted from the effects of a bullet wound, and that the bullet entered behind the ear and that the shot was fired at a distance of six or eight inches from the head.

The view for the murdered general will be held tomorrow at the body will afterwards be taken to Russia.
