An Act to amend the Act 7th Vic., cap. 13, for the better preservation of certain species of Fish.

**W**HEREAS in the first enacting Clause of the Act passed in the seventh year of Her present Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for the better preservation of certain species of Fish in the rivers and waters of the Counties therein mentioned,*" the species of Fish called "Salmon" was omitted to be included; and whereas it is expedient to extend the said Act to include the same, as well as otherwise to extend the provisions of said Act; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

Preamble.

7 V. c. 13.

That the above cited Act shall have force in relation to the species of Fish called "Salmon," as fully as if the same had been included in the first enacting Clause of said Act, and the provisions of the said cited Act shall extend to the County of Megantic as well as to the other Counties therein mentioned.
