This is to be taken for granted, and accepted as a matter of course. It may, however, be that in such a case as the present, a Canadian order-in-council should be issued with respect to Great Britain, as well as with respect to the United States. For what is to be done to affect the former, comes into force only as a consequence of a proceeding approval of the latter. Making certain articles free from the United States is the active cause of a change in the situation, which is a consequence that the same articles may be free from Great Britain. And as a condition of such a proceeding, it may be desired to have the law only to make official publication of the fact.

And yet not very long ago it was wholly supported by some of our Conservative Unionists, not only that Canada was to be free to make a treaty with a foreign power, but that in Mr. Brown's opinion in 1874 there exists a good precedent for it.
