BARLEY DUTY 35 PER CENT. MOTION TO DEFEAT THE WILSON SCHEDULE DEFEATED.

One Congressman Moved to Make It Free—An Advocate of Sweeping Amendments to the Tariff and the House Schedules Has an Uproar.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 21.—In the House Saturday, after some dickerings between Mr. Wilson and Mr. Burrows, it was agreed that debate on the pending amendment to the tariff on the agricultural section of the McKinley law for the corresponding section of the Wilson bill should close in twenty minutes. An agreement was also reached whereby three hours are to be given to the consideration of the coal schedule and an hour to the iron schedule on Tuesday.

Wilson Barley Clause Hands. Mr. Daniels (Rep., N.Y.) offered an amendment putting barley on the free list, but it was voted down.

The vote was then taken on Henderson's amendment, substituting the existing law for the proposed agricultural schedule of the Wilson bill, and the amendment was defeated by a vote of 63 in the affirmative to 116 in the negative.
