

Quest. What is thy duty towards God? Answ. My duty towards God, is to believe in him, to fear him, and to love him, with all my heart, with all my mind, with all my soul, and with all my strength; to worship him, to give him thanks, to put my whole trust in him, to call upon him, to honour his holy Name and his Word; and to serve him truly all the days of my life.

Answ. My duty towards my neighbour, is to love him as myself, and to do all men, as I would they should do unto me. To love, honour, and succour my father and mother: To honour and obey the Queen, and all that are put in authority under her: To submit myself to all my governors, teachers, spiritual pastors and masters: To order myself lowly and reverently to all my betters: To hurt no body by word nor deed: To be true and just in all my dealing: To bear no malice nor hatred in my heart: To keep my hands from picking and stealing, and my tongue from evil-speaking, lying, and slandering: To keep my body in temperance, soberness, and chastity: Not to covet nor desire other men's goods; but to learn and labour truly to get my own living, and to do my duty in that state of life, unto which it shall please God to call me.

Quest. What is the outward visible sign or form in Baptism?

Answ. Water; wherein the person is: baptized In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.

Answ. A death unto sin, and a new birth unto righteousness: for being by nature born in sin, and the children of wrath, we are hereby made the children of grace.

Quest. What is required of persons to

Answ. Repentance, whereby they forsake sin; and faith, whereby they stedfastly believe the promises of God made to them in that Sacrament.

Quest. Why then are Infants baptized, when by reason of their tender age they

cannot perform them?

Answ. Because they promise them both by their sureties; which promise, when they come to age, themselves are bound to perform.

Quest. Why was the Sacrament of the

Lord's Supper ordained?

Answ. For the continual remembrance of the sacrifice of the death of Christ, and of the benefits which we receive thereby.

Quest. What is the outward part or

sign of the Lord's Supper?

Answ. Bread and wine, which the Lord

hath commanded to be received.

Quest. What is the inward part, or thing signified?

Answ. The body and blood of Christ, which are verily and indeed taken and received by the faithful in the Lord's Supper.

Quest. What are the benefits whereof

we are partakers thereby?

Answ. The strengthening and refreshing of our souls by the body and blood of Christ, as our bodies are by the bread and wine.
