RESOLUTION OF COMMITTEE

"That the Secretary shall, previously to each Quarterly Meeting, prepare a tabular view of the numerical and financial state of the Mission; also a synoptical statement of the business to be done; and in order to do this, Missions shall hold their quarterly meetings sufficiently early to enable them to have their reports to the Mission Office not less than one week previously to the meeting of the Committee; and in case any of the Missionaries shall fail in doing so, their reports shall not be read, nor their grants sent until the succeeding meeting. The Committee earnestly hopes that all the brethren will assist in enabling the Secretary to carry out the above arrangement, so that they may have time to discuss what really pertains to the good of the Mission work."

The Quarterly Meeting of these Committees shall be held in Toronto, on Thursday, the 9th of August, and Thursday the 8th of November, 1877; Thursday, 7th of February, and Thursday, the 2nd of May, 1878. Each Meeting to commence at 9 o'clock A.M.

REPORT.

To the Ministers, Collectors and Friends of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada:

DEAR BRETHREN AND FRIENDS:—It is at all times pleasurable to address you in the annual report of this cause of Christian Missions, with which it is an honor to have a connection. But especially it is so to address you when we are in a position to tell you, that, by the blessing of God upon the labors of your agents, success has been achieved. It is a pleasurable thing to be able to report progress in any undertaking of a philanthropic character, or, which is in any way associated with the cause of Christ and the church; but most of all pleasurable to report prosperity in the work of Christian Missions. The year just closed has, spiritually and numerically, been one of great prosperity. Many reports of this appeared in the "Christian Journal," which no doubt many of you read, and which need not be repeated here. Notwithstanding the usual number of losses by removals, death, &c., the increase of members reported by Conference is 384, a fair proportion of that increase being on the Mission stations, and what is equally a cause of thankfulness is the increasing spirituality and devotion to God and his work observable on a number of stations. We rejoice over the good done by the labors of the servants of Christ, whose stations are under the care of your committee. It is encouraging to know that many souls are saved as the years pass, families are blessed by the labors of God's servants, communities are in many ways benefitted beside the spiritual good they receive. There is a large amount of good done which can never be tabulated, some of which is known to your agents, but much more which will never appear till the day of final reckoning. The good we know of is worth infinitely more than all the labor and money expended to produce it. But when we add to that the good we know not of, but of which the Omniscient One has a perfect knowledge and a correct account, and which he will bring forth in the great day, we should be the more encouraged. How small will our labors and givings appear when placed by the side of the good resulting therefrom, and when viewed in the light of eternity. As the friends of the cause of God, therefore, you may take encouragement from the fact that your labors and giving are not in vain in the Lord. It is well sometimes to review the past, so that we may have before our minds by comparison, the advancement we are making. Such a review of the last five years for instance, will show the Mission stations under the oversight of your committee to have, in many respects, made very encouraging progress. In the five years there

has been an increase of over 800 members. The ordinary income has risen from about \$7,460 to about \$13,700, being an increase of about \$6,230. Many extras are not included in the above figures. The missionary money on those stations has risen from about \$2,770 to about \$3,750, being an increase of nearly a thousand dollars, and that notwithstanding the hard times so much spoken of. The total increased income is over \$7,000. The increased expenditure is more than \$6,000. A glance at the church property will show its increased value to be quite as encouraging as that of the ordinary income, as it has risen from something over \$70,000 to about \$123,000, or about \$50,000 of an increase. The debt has been increased \$5,000, so that the nett cash increase in value of church property is \$45,000. It will be seen by comparing this statement with the yearly balance sheet, that the annual increase in the value of Mission Church property is more than the amount that those missions cost the Missionary Committee to sustain them. We would not write so as to be thought boastful—for we have nothing to boast about—but we do think the above facts are something to be thankful for. Certainly it is a very much more favorable and encouraging view of our Mission work than some of our friends would expect, and we hope that in view of these facts many of our friends, who are able to do so, will be prevailed upon to increase their contributions the coming year. The financial statement for the year closing with June 30th, 1877, is briefly the following:—

Comparing the statement with that of last year, we find the income from the stations over \$800 less than last year. We do not say this ought not to have been, but, it is to be regretted that it should be. The English Conference gave an additional grant of £50 for Montreal that was of considerable relief to your committee, and which, with the exercise of the greatest possible economy on the part of your committee, has so reduced the expenditure that it exceeds the income by only \$33.37. It is right, however, to say that the expenditure cannot possibly be kept at the present amount, and that the action taken, of necessity, by the Conference in employing more agents, &c., will materially increase the expenditure the coming year. In order that your committee may feel free to encourage brethren laboring on Mission stations, and those who are associated with them in Christian work, as well as extend the work in a prudent

way, more money than the amount placed at the disposal of your committee in the past year is absolutely necessary. We, therefore, in the name of the Lord and for the sake of souls that may be saved by the labors of God's servants, and to sustain and extend the work of God, appeal to you for increased financial aid, thus adding practical sympathy with your earnest prayers. We would not say one word in reference to the past which would even appear like a complaint, but would take this opportunity of expressing the most hearty thanks of the Missionary Committee to the numerous friends of the cause of Missions. Still, it would be cause for yet greater thankfulness, if a large number of our friends would make up their minds to increase their subscriptions the coming year. No doubt many of you are well able to do so, if you think the matter over. Such is the position of the Mission Fund as to need—greatly need—an increased income. May we suggest to the friends of our Missions to examine how long it is since they increased their subscriptions to the Mission Fund, and by applying the Scriptural rule of giving as the Lord has prospered you, find thus how much you require to advance, so as to meet the principle contained in the rule. Many of you who have been giving about a dollar a year, for many years, while you have been increasing your personal property, will, no doubt find yourselves able to double or even increase your subscriptions four-fold, if you but prayerfully think the matter over, and view it in the light of the necessities of the Fund, and the claims of God upon you, claims arising from a consideration of what the Gospel of God's grace has done for you and your families, both temporally and spiritually. We also earnestly request those of you who have given larger sums than those referred to above, to give this subject of increased subscriptions, your prayerful consideration. This subject is of such importance that we have thought it best to speak in as plain and practical a way as possible on it, with the earnest hope that you will respond in as hearty and liberal a manner as your circumstances will justify, and the claims of God upon you call for.

We would take this opportunity to again acknowledge gratefully the continued practical sympathy of our esteemed brethren in Britain, as will be seen by the financial statement. They not only gave us the usual grant allowed for a few years past, but an additional sum of £50 for the Montreal mission. The Conference requested them to increase the grant, and also in some way grant us some aid in building a Church in Montreal: we do not know as yet what has been done in these cases. We are sure, however, that such is their sympathy with us, that they will do all they can. The claims of their work in England, Scotland, Ireland, the Colonies, and Africa, are very great, yet they will aid us to the extent of their ability.

Our friends in the old land are still pushing forward the work of God with great vigor and earnestness, and God is blessing them with wonderful success. Doors of usefulness appear opening to them in

every direction, and the work of God in their hands is extended and built up. Many extracts, deeply interesting, might be given from their soul-stirring reports, but want of space forbids anything like lengthy extracts. The following may be taken as an example of their Mission work, taken from their Missionary Report:—

DARTFORD.—“This station is doing well; we have opened two new Mission Rooms during the year. One belongs to an Hotel-keeper, and the other is next door to a public house.” The writer says, “I was preaching in one last Sunday week. The hotel-keeper and his family were present, and with them a gentleman who holds a high office in parliament, who gave a sovereign to the collection, and after the service, he said to the gentleman the room belongs to, ‘I have been accustomed in every official capacity to attend St. Paul’s, and have given £50 at the collection. I have heard the Archbishop of Canterbury and others, but I have never heard any that has made me feel like I felt in that Mission Room this afternoon. Give these people all the encouragement you can, and when you want any help send to me and you shall have it.’ The other week a Church Clergyman sent for me to dine with him, I went, and he said to me, ‘You are doing a good work in the town,’ and without asking he said, ‘I feel great pleasure in giving you five pounds to help you in your work.’ Some of the worst characters in the town have been saved. C. G. said, ‘that in thirty years he had spent a fortune in public houses, but he has now done with them and the drink for ever.’ He and his wife with two daughters are converted and members of our church. He supplies hundreds of houses every Sunday with tracts and pays for them himself. M. H., who is a very intelligent man, said, ‘For twenty years I never opened a Bible, and during that time I have spent almost one pound a week in the public house. I am now truly happy and would not give up Christ for all the world.’”

The African work is succeeding as well as could be expected. The heroic men who have labored previously in Fernando-Po are giving evidence of their willingness again to face difficulty, and suffer the effects of the deadly climate in order to win the heathen to Christ. Rev. Mr. Burnett, one of the first two who went to the Island, is now laboring there again, and Rev. Mr. Holland, who returned to England some time since, has gone back to the work among the heathen. Rev. Mr. Parr, who has just come back to England will remain till his strength is recruited, and then return to open a new Mission among the natives. They are doing a great work, in which the church will yet have cause greatly to rejoice. Much that is instructive and interesting might be given of this work, but we have not space for it.

In conclusion, dear friends, we again commend to your believing prayers, and your hearty sympathy and liberality this good work, the work of God, of Christ, and souls, and while commanding to your liberality this good work, we would also commend you and yours to the mercy and grace of God our Father, and to the word of His grace, that our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work.
