700 DETECTIVES ON DUTY
At New York elections to-day to prevent illegal voting.

New York, Nov. 4.—The registered voters in Greater New York numbering 600,000, began gradually at 6 o'clock this morning to vote for themselves the mayor and the members of the legislature.

Extraordinary precautions were taken to prevent illegal voting and any intimidation of voters at the polls. Police Commissioner Waide long before daybreak had ordered every police captain to the five boroughs of the city transferred to some other precinct.

At his new post until 8 o'clock Wednesday morning, 700 detectives and plainclothes men were assigned to work, running down persons attempting to vote illegally and among them were the "G-men" for "Guerilla" who, according to leaders of the Fusion campaign, had been employed in some quarters to intimidate voters.

The more prominent candidates for Mayor are Edward E. McCall, the Tammany nominee, and John P. McLean, the young man named by the Fusionists, although the Independent League and the Socialists are also in the race. Republicans, Progressives and Independents are represented among the Fusionists, who have made their main issue the defeat of Tammany.
