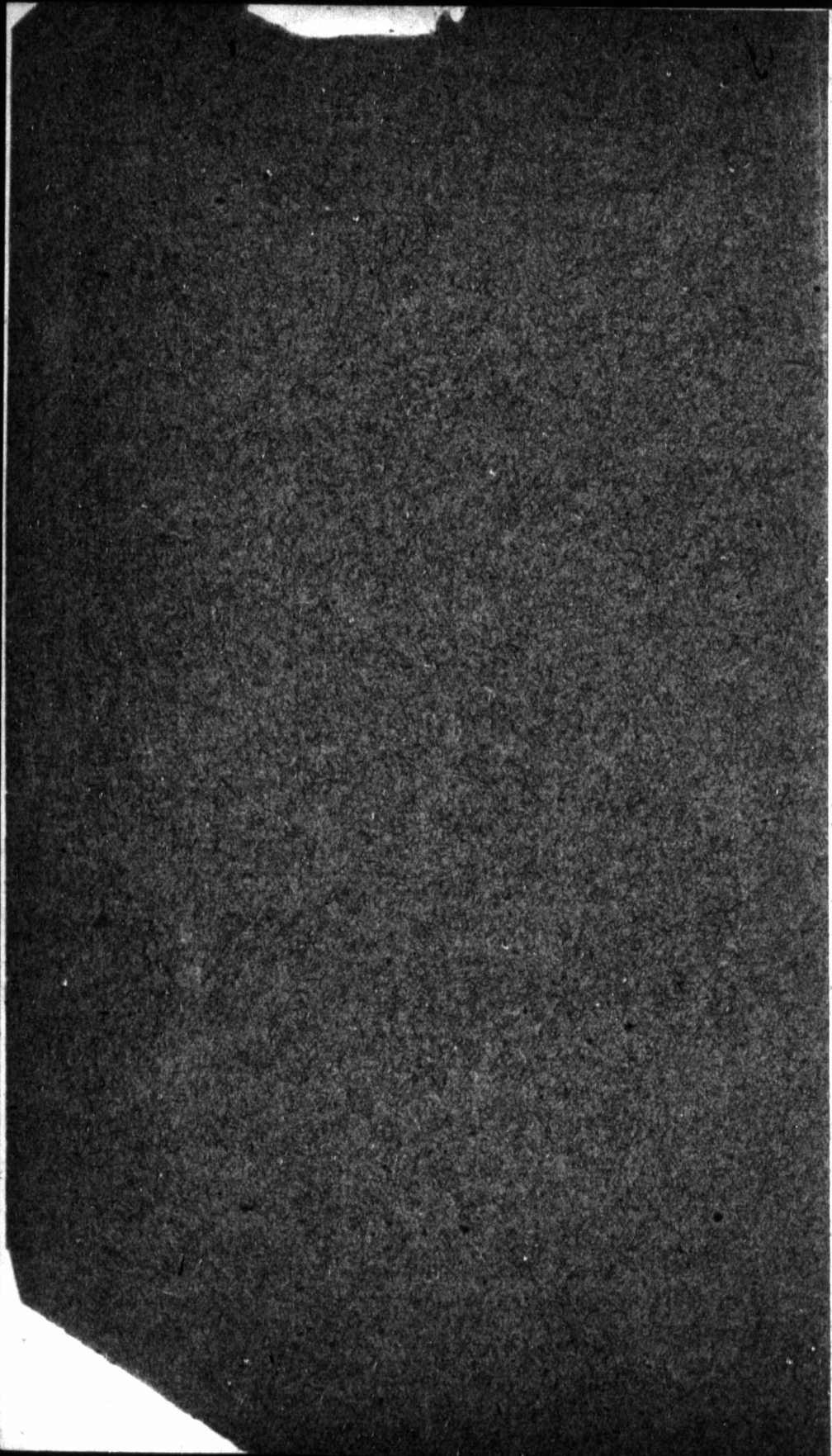

The Upper Canada Journals were not so regularly or continuously printed till the year 1825, and it is seldom that a copy before that date is met with. In 1819 the Legislature of Upper Canada appropriated £354.11s. Sterling (\$1,772) to procure copies of the Journals which had been destroyed by the enemy in 1813. As there were 21 years Journals to be obtained, the appropriation assessed \$84 to the value of each volume, 85 years ago. Few, if any, so procured survive the repeated destruction of the Parliament buildings by fire. When the late Mr. Alpheus Todd, Librarian of the Parliament Library at Ottawa, indexed the Journals, he was not able to carry the index back beyond the year 1825.

Narrative of Travels in the Northern Part of the American Continent, embracing the whole stretch of Northwestern Canada between Hudson's Bay and the Pacific Ocean and adjacent American territory, performed between the years 1784 and 1813. During the whole of this period Thompson was continuously employed in the region; at first, during six years, in the service of the Hudson Bay Company, and during the remaining years as astronomer and surveyor of the Northwest Company. He was a keen observer, and took note of everything relating to the country, its wild men and wild animals, which he deemed worth preserving. He married a half-breed Nahathaway woman, and in that way obtained special insight into the character of the Indians. Thompson was the second white man to cross the Continent north of the mouth of the Columbia River, Sir Alexander Mackenzie alone having preceded him. He crossed the Rocky Mountains by several different passes, and once passed down a great distance south from the Peace River. He visited Fort Astoria when it was in course of construction, and his discoveries played an important part in diplomatic discussion on disputed territorial claims on the international boundary between Canada and the United States. As astronomer for the Northwest Company he determined the latitude and longitude of a great number of places, and kept records of temperature at points separated by vast distances. The MS. covers about 600 pages of foolscap, averaging 400 words to the page. Thompson's capability for work of the kind in which he was engaged was afterwards recognized by more than one government. In settling the international boundary under the Treaty of Ghent, through the whole lake and river region, he represented the British Government, and did nearly all the work. The MS. has never been published.
